- ❖ India – Russia Agriculture Business summit held in Newdelhi.
- ❖ As Pera report by Association for Democratic Reforms (ADR) and National Election Watch (NEW), 35% of incumbent chief minister in India have criminal cases against them.
 - Andhra Pradesh CM Chandrababu Naidu is the richest among all Chief Ministers and Tripura CM Manik Sarkar has the lowest declared assets.
