## June 11 - Green Mizoram Day

- India will soon have its first national police museum in New Delhi.
- Union Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change has proposed to declare areas around the Chitrangudi Bird Sanctuary and Karaivetti Bird Sanctuary Eco-Sensitive Zones (ESZ) in Tamilnadu.
- 600 sports nurseries to be opened in Haryana to boost sports in the state.
- The government is set to unveil a Rs.500-crore credit enhancement fund to facilitate infrastructure investments by insurance and pension funds.
- Tata Power Renewable Energy Ltd. (TPREL), wholly owned subsidiary of Tata Power, has won a 150 MW solar PV project on a long term basis in Maharashtra.
- Common Service Centres (CSCs) that provide Internet infrastructure to rural areas will act as banking correspondents.
- Two memorandums of understanding (MoU) were signed between CSC and IRCTC for reservation of rail tickets.
- Haryana to organise awareness campaign for farmers about the negative effects of stubble burning, its alternatives and various farmer welfare schemes.
- 11th World Hindi Conference in Mauritius is likely to increase the popularity of Hindi globally organised every three years by the External Affairs Ministry.
- India will host the first military exercise of the BIMSTEC (Bay of Bengal Initiative for Multi-Sectoral Technical and Economic Cooperation) group focussing on counter-terrorism in Pune in the second week of September.

- Rail MADAD (Mobile Application for Desired Assistance During travel) An App to expedite & streamline passenger grievance redressal.
