

## **JUNE 25 CURRENT AFFAIRS**

- 'Paani Bachao, Paise Kamao' campaign was launched to encourage farmers aimed at checking depletion of underground water in Punjab villages Bambiwal and Nawajipur, initially.
- Haryana, Godikan village panchayat passes 'No toilet, no bride' resolution; inspired by Akshay Kumar movie 'Toilet-Ek Prem Katha'.
- The Airports Authority of India has proposed to set up a water aerodrome in Chilika Lake for starting amphibious aircraft operations in Odisha.
- The first All India Halegannada Sahitya Sammelana at Shravanabelgola, Karnataka.
- Oil India Limited (OIL), has made its second hydrocarbon discovery in the onland KG Basin NELP VI Block.
- The Asian Infrastructure Investment Bank (AIIB) is likely to invest USD 200 million in a fund of funds set up by India to take interest in infra projects.
