

### Prime Minister International Visit and Important Details – 2014

Country	Date	Important Events During Visit
Bhutan	June 15, 16, 2014	His first foreign visit to Bhutan following an invitation by King Jigme Khesar Namgyel Wangchuck and Tobgay. The visit was called by the media as a "charm offensive". He had inaugurated the Supreme Court Complex in Bhutan and also promised help to Bhutan on the IT and digital sectors
Brazil	July 13 -16, 2014	The 6th BRICS summit was held at the north-eastern beach city of Fortaleza. In the Fortaleza summit the group have agreed to establish a financial institution rivaling the Western-dominated World Bank and IMF, The bank would be named the New Development Bank as suggested by the Indian side but the Modi government failed to bag the bank's headquarters for New Delhi.
Nepal	August 3,4, 2014	The last visit of an Indian prime minister to Nepal was 17 years ago in 1997 by I. K. Gujral. The talks with Nepal were focused on reviewing the 1950's Treaty of Peace and Friendship, India - funded <b>hydro electricity projects</b> in Nepal and other infrastructure projects in Nepal
Japan	Aug 30 - Sep 3, 2014	His first bilateral state visit outside the subcontinent. During his visit, official negotiations on the sale of US 2 amphibious aircraft for the Indian Navy and the long pending civil nuclear agreements have both progressed and elevating of the already established strategic partnership to the "Special Strategic Global Partnership"
United States	Sep 26 -30, 2014	Modi delivered his maiden speech in the <b>69th session of the United Nations General Assembly</b> on 27 September 2014. In this regard, he also asked world leaders and UN officials to recognise and observe Yoga Day, in order to emphasise the importance of incorporating Yoga into a modern-day lifestyle
Myanmar	November 11-13, 2014	For Attend 9th East Asia Summit
Australia	November 14 -18, 2014	For Attend G-20 Brisbane Summit
Fiji	November 19,2014	Modi became the first Indian head of government to visit Fiji after 33 years, since Indira Gandhi's visit in 1981. While there, he also attended a 'Forum for India-Pacific Island cooperation' along with leaders from all 14 Pacific islands nations.
Nepal	November 25 -27, 2014	For Attend 18th SAARC Summit, This was Modi's first ever SAARC summit.
