

**Prime Minister International Visit and Important Details – 2015**

Country	Date	Important Events During Visit
Seychelles	March 10, 11, 2015	Modi's visit to Seychelles was part of his "Indian Ocean outreach" program. While there, he held talks with President James Alexis Michelin order to strengthen maritime ties and enhance bilateral development and cooperation.
Mauritius	March 11 - 13, 2015	Modi was the chief guest at the Mauritian National Day on 12 March
Sri Lanka	March 13 - 14, 2015	Modi was scheduled to visit Sri Lanka earlier, in January 2015. He eventually made this visit from 13–15 March 2015, following newly-inaugurated Sri Lankan President Maithripala Sirisena's visit to New Delhi in February. During this trip, Modi also visited the city of Jafna in the Northern Province
Singapore	March 23, 2015	Prime Minister Modi attended the state-funeral of Lee Kuan Yew, the first Prime Minister of Singapore.
France	April 9 - 12, 2015	During his visit, Prime Minister Modi encouraged French companies to participate in the Make In India programme in defense, civil nuclear power and food processing
Germany	April 12 - 14, 2015	Modi had worked out a state visit to Berlin following his first meeting with German chancellor Angela Merkel. Modi, most notably, visited Hannover where he pitched his Make in India campaign to various German industries.
Canada	April 14 - 16, 2015	Modi addressed a huge gathering of overseas Indians in Toronto, similar to his previous Madison Square Garden event
China	May 14 - 16, 2015	Modi made his first visit to the People's Republic of China in May 2015. President Xi Jinping received Modi in Xi'an, his home town (akin to Xi's Ahmedabad trip last September, the home town of Modi), before official talks in Beijing.
Mongolia	May 16 - 17, 2015	Modi become the first Indian Prime Minister to visit Mongolia. During his visit, he boosted talks on the supplying of Mongolian Uranium to India. A \$1 Billion line of credit was extended to Mongolia, for infrastructure development, amongst many other fields. The Foundation of IT Center was laid by Indian Prime Minister Narendra Modi on May 17, 2015
South Korea	May 18 - 19, 2015	Modi's visit to South Korea was part of India's East Asia policy and Modi's attempt to promote his Make in India concept to Korean investors

Bangladesh	June 6 - 7, 2015	Prime Minister Narendra Modi paid a State visit to Bangladesh from June 6 – 7, 2015 at the invitation of H.E. Sheikh Hasina, Prime Minister of Bangladesh. During this visit, the Prime Minister discussed the ratification of the India-Bangladesh Land Boundary Agreement - 1974 & Protocol- 2011. During the visit India extended a US\$2 billion line of credit to Bangladesh & pledged US\$5 billion worth of investments. As per the agreements, India's Reliance Power agreed to invest US\$3 billion to set up a 3,000 MW LNG-based power plant (which is the single largest foreign investment ever made in Bangladesh). Adani Power will also be setting up a 1600 MW coal-fired power plant at a cost of US\$1.5 billion. The two countries signed a total of 22 agreements including the ones on maritime safety co-operation and curbing human trafficking and fake Indian currency. Modi also announced a line of credit of \$2 billion to Bangladesh
Russia	July 8 - 10, 2015	For Attend 7th BRICS summit. This was his second BRICS summit after he took office as Prime Minister of India in 2014. This was also a part of his first state visit to Moscow.
United Arab Emirates	August 16,17, 2015	This was the first Prime ministerial visit to the gulf nation 34 years after Indira Gandhi. In a break from protocol which would have seen only Foreign Minister Sheikh Abdullah receive dignitaries, Crown Prince Sheikh Mohammed Bin Zayed Al Nahyan, along with his five brothers, was also present to receive Modi. The aim of the visit was to increase bilateral cooperation in energy and trade, and market India as an attractive business destination.
United States	Sep 24 - 30, 2015	United Nations General Assembly and Official visit to Silicon valley. This was his second visit to the United States as prime minister and third bilateral summit with Obama.
United Kingdom	Nov 12 - 16, 2015	During the visit, Modi became the first Indian Prime Minister to address the British Parliament.[33] The Times of India reported that agents from Mossad and MI5 were protecting Prime Minister Narendra Modi who was heading to the 2015 G-20 Summit in Antalya, Turkey
Turkey	Nov 15 - 16, 2015	For Attend G-20 Summit in Antalya, Turkey
Malaysia	Nov 21- 22, 2015	For Attend ASEAN-India Summit & East Asia Summit
Singapore	Nov 23-25, 2015	Singaporean Prime Minister Lee Hsien Loong invited Modi to visit Singapore in 2015 to commemorate the 50th anniversary of India and Singapore's bilateral ties
France	Nov 30 - Dec 1, 2015	Prime Minister Modi participated in the Leaders Event of the COP21 (2015 United Nations Climate Change Conference) conference to set out India's Strategy to contain global warming.

Afghanistan	December 25,2015	On 24 December 2015, India donated three Mi-25 attack helicopters (with an option to send one more in future) to Afghanistan as part of the bilateral strategic partnership to counter the Taliban. The next day, 25 December, Indian PM Narendra Modi visited Kabul to open the newly constructed Afghan parliament opposite the ruins of the Darul Aman Palace, which had been built by India for \$90 million.
Pakistan	December 25,2015	Informal meeting with Pakistani Prime Minister Nawaz Sharif at Lahore on his way back from Kabul to Delhi. Modi become the first Indian Prime Minister to visit Pakistan since 2004.
