Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Grameen Kaushalya Yojana	25-Sep-14	It is a Goveronment of India Project to engage rural youth specially BPL and SC/ST segment of population, in gainful employment through skill training programmes.
Integrated Rural Development Program	1978	self-employment program to raise the income-generation capacity of target groups among the poor and The scheme has been merged with another scheme named Swarnajayanti Gram Swarozgar Yojana (SGSY) since 01.04 1999.
Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Act	6-Feb-06	Legal guarantee for one hundred days of employment in every financial year to adult members of any rural household willing to do public work-related unskilled manual work at the statutory minimum wage of Rs. 120 per day in 2009 prices.
Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana	25-Dec-00	Good all-weather road connectivity to unconnected villages
Rajiv Gandhi Grameen Vidyutikaran Yojana	Apr-05	Programme for creation of Rural Electricity Infrastructure & Household Electrification for providing access to electricity to rural households
Sampoorna Grameen Rozgar Yojana	25-Sep-01	Providing additional wage employment and food security, alongside creation of durable community assets in rural areas.
Swarnajayanti Gram Swarozgar Yojana	1-Apr-99	Bring the assisted poor families above the poverty line by organising them into Self Help Groups (SHGs) through the process of social mobilisation, their training and capacity building and provision of income generating assets through a mix of bank credit and government subsidy.
