Jawaharlal Nehru National Urban Renewal Mission (JnNURM)	3-Dec-05	a programme meant to improve the quality of life and infrastructure in the cities. To be replaced by Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation.
Pooled Finance Development Fund Scheme	29-Sep-06	Pooled Finance Development Fund (PFDF), which would enable the Urban Local Bodies (ULBs) including small and medium sized municipalities to raise funds from the market on a sustainable basis to meet their investment needs. PFDF will provide credit enhancement to ULBs to access market borrowings based on their credit worthiness through State level Pooled Finance Mechanism viz. a State Pooled Finance Entity (SPEF).
Rajiv Awas Yojana	2013	It envisages a "Slum Free India" with inclusive and equitable cities in which every citizen has access to basic civic infrastructure and social amenities and decent shelter
HRIDAY – Heritage City Development and Augmentation Yojana	Jan-15	The scheme seeks to preserve and rejuvenate the rich cultural heritage of the country.
Smart Cities Mission	25-Jun-15	To enable better living and drive economic growth stressing on the need for people centric urban planning and development.
AMRUT	25-Jun-15	To enable better living and drive economic growth stressing on the need for people centric urban planning and development.
