- The **Rajasthan Cabinet** has decided to take a loan worth Rs.5,000 crore from the National Cooperative Development Corporation (NCDC) for funding the State government's **crop loan waiver scheme for farmers.**
- The Commissionerate of Treasuries and Accounts, Government of Tamil Nadu, will be rolling out the Online Bill Passing System and e-SR (service record digitalisation) as a part of the Integrated Financial and Human Resource Management System, this October.
- A world class exhibition on four eminent personalities of Bengal, Gurudev Rabindranath Tagore, Netaji Subha Chandra Bose, Rishi Bankim Chandra Chattopadhyay and Dr. Shyama Prasad Mukherjee would be organized very soon at National Library in Kolkata at permanent basis.
- The Government has proposed to set up **National Resource Centres** (**NRCs**) to prepare online training material.
- A decision to establish a **BRICS Media Academy** and a **BRICS news portal** were among those taken at the **2018 BRICS Media Forum at Cape Town in South Africa**.
- **Russia**'s military is **testing an array of new nuclear** and other weapons, from a **high-powered laser weapon system** to a nuclear-powered cruise missile with "unlimited" range.
- France has become just the third country to bring women onboard its nuclear-powered subs after the U.S. and Britain.
- **ISRO** has roped in **three partners** to help it **assemble 27 satellites at a quick pace** over the next three years.
- A Japanese start-up developing the world's first artificial meteor shower in a spectacular show over Hiroshima in early 2020.



- **The Reserve Bank of India** will issue **new Rs.100 notes**, which would be smaller in size than the present ones.
- Mahindra and Mahindra (M&M) plans to unveil its e-autorickshaw by the fourth quarter of this financial year.
- Canada Pension Plan Investment Board (CPPIB) is looking for opportunities to invest in Indian infrastructure, power and real estate projects.
- National Mission for Clean Ganga (NMCG) is running "Ganga VriksharopanAbhiyan" in five main stem Ganga basin states Uttarakhand, Uttar Pradesh, Bihar, Jharkhand and West Bengal.
- CSIR-NPL signed a MoU with HPCL for indigenous development of petroleum certified reference materials (CRMs) under trade name of Bhartiya Niredeshak Dravyas (BNDTM).
- The Lok Sabha passed the Fugitive Economic Offenders Bill, which will now replace the Ordinance by the same name promulgated by the President in April.

- India wins one silver (Divya Kakran) and two bronze medals (Karuna, Reena) at the junior Asian wrestling championships.
