

- Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi, will pay a State Visit to Republic of Rwanda, Republic of Uganda and Republic of South Africa. This will be the first visit by an Indian Prime Minister to Rwanda and the first visit by our Prime Minister to Uganda in over 20 years.
- The Bihar government has decided to grant reservation in promotions to Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes personnel.
- The country's first public bicycle sharing (PBS) system Trin Trin has clocked 10,000 registrations in Mysuru.
- Shri Nitin Gadkari, Minister of Road Transport & Highways, Shipping, Water Resources, River Development & Ganga Rejuvenation inaugurated/laid the foundation for 5 National Highways projects in Madhya Pradesh.
- Vocational Training Centres (VTCs) have been established under the name 'Kalyan Gurukul' under Welfare Department, Government of Jharkhand.
