Date	Day	Details
June 01	World Milk Day	This day was founded by the Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations (FAO), India is the largest producer of milk. It also celebrates National Milk Day on November 26th. This day marks the birth anniversary of Verghese Kurien, the Father of White Revolution in India. 2018 theme in India – “Drink Move Be Strong”.
June 03	World Bicycle Day	On June 3, 2018, the first official World Bicycle Day will be celebrated. It was approved on 12 April 2018 as an official United Nations day of awareness about the multiple societal benefits of using the bicycle for transport and leisure.
June 05	World Environment Day 2018	World Environment Day (WED) 2018 is being celebrated with India being the global host nation for the 43rd edition of the event. 2018 Theme – ‘Beat plastic pollution’
June 08	World Oceans Day	World Oceans Day to raise awareness of the vital importance of our oceans and the role they play in sustaining a healthy planet. They are the lungs of our planet, providing most of the oxygen we breathe. 2018 Theme – Preventing plastic pollution and encouraging solutions for a healthy ocean.
June 11	Green Mizoram Day	The Green Mizoram Day is being organized every year on June 11 since 1999.
June 12	World Day Against Child Labour	The International Labour Organization (ILO) launched the World Day Against Child Labour in 2002 to focus attention on the global extent of child labour and the action and efforts needed to eliminate it. 2018 theme - ‘Generation Safe & Healthy’
June 14	World Blood Donor Day	Every year, on 14 June, countries around the world celebrate World Blood Donor Day. The event serves to thank voluntary, unpaid blood donors for their life-saving gifts of blood and to raise awareness of the need for regular blood donations. 2018 Theme - Be there for someone else. Give blood. Share life
June 18	Goa Revolution Day	The struggle which began 72 years back (in 1946) resulted in the liberation of Goa in 1961.
June 20	World Refugee Day 2018	Annual event, held on the same date each year, and 2018 is the 18th year of the event, run by the United Nations Refugee Agency, to state that the world supports and stands with refugees. The event is about raising global awareness of global responsibility for refugees. 2018 Theme – “Now more than ever, we need to stand #WithRefugees”

June 21	Fourth International Yoga Day	It's a global event that takes place each year on June 21 and aims to raise awareness of the benefits of practicing yoga. 2018 theme – “Yoga for Peace”
	World Music Day	The Fête de la Musique, also known as Music Day, Make Music Day or World Music Day, is an annual music celebration that takes place on 21 June.
June 23	Olympic Day	In January 1948, the International Olympic Committee approved the idea of Olympic Day to commemorate the creation of the IOC on 23 June 1894 in Paris. 2018 Olympic Day is 70th Anniversary for Olympic Day
June 26	International Day against Drug Abuse and Illicit Trafficking	The International Day Against Drug Abuse and Illicit Trafficking is an effort of the United Nations aimed at strengthening action and spreading awareness about drug abuse and illegal drug trade in the world. 2018 Theme – “Listening to children and youth is the first step to help them grow healthy and safe”
June 27	United Nations Micro, Small and Medium-sized Enterprises Day	Micro, Small and Medium-sized Enterprises (MSMEs) Day is celebrated each year on 27 June. MSME Day 2018 will be dedicated to youth and will cover topics such as youth entrepreneurship and youth employment. MSME Day 2018 Theme – ‘The Youth Dimension’
June 29	National Statistics Day	To create public awareness about the importance of statistics in socio-economic planning and policy formulation, and to acknowledge the contribution of Late Professor Prasanta Chandra Mahalanobis. 2018 Theme – “Quality Assurance in Official Statistics”
