International

Informal Gathering of World Trade Organization (WTO) Ministers

UN India Business Forum

• The UN India Business Forum and the Women Entrepreneurial Platform of NITI Aayog formed a consortium to reduce gender disparities in start-up investments by providing mentorship and networking opportunities and accelerating financial and market linkages for women entrepreneurs.

5. Science and Technology

Novel initiative to encourage science communication

• The Augmenting Writing Skills for Articulating Research (AWSAR) initiative will each year reward 100 best articles by PhD students with cash prize of Rs.1,00,000 each and a certificate of appreciation.

Gene mapping of 3,000 bacteria to help fight deadly superbugs

• Scientists seeking new ways to fight drug-resistant superbugs have mapped the genomes of more than 3,000 bacteria, including samples of a bug taken from Alexander Fleming's nose and a dysentery-causing strain from a First World War soldier.

Polyethylene plastic with antibacterial properties

Silver nano particle-embedded plastics were found to have greater than 99% antibacterial activity
against common bacterial pathogens like Escherchia coli and Staphylococcus aureus by the IIT Delhi
team.

Koko, the gorilla dies at 46

• The Gorilla Foundation said that the 46-year-old western lowland gorilla named Koko died who knows sign language.

Merger between two sciences will enhance treatment options in India

- In a first, researchers from India will study the proteins and genes of cancer tumors simultaneously.
- The aim of the merger between the two promising sciences (proteomics and genomics) is to derive new medications as well as offer personalized cancer therapies.
- India became the 12th country to join the International Cancer Proteogenome Consortium (ICPC) of the National Cancer Institute (NCI), U.S.



US scientists, ship visiting Goa to boost Indian Ocean studies

• A team of 20 scientists, along with a key vessel of the United States National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA), are arriving in Goa marking their expanding cooperation with Indian scientists in the study of the Indian Ocean.

Gene editing tool may raise cancer risk in cells

- CRISPR-Cas9, a gene-editing technology that is being explored by scientists worldwide as a way of removing and replacing gene defects might inadvertently increase cancer risk in cells, scientists warned on June 11.
- CRISPR-Cas9 triggers a mechanism designed to protect cells from DNA damage, making gene editing more difficult

IIT Hyderabad builds dataset to understand online user-engagement

• IIT Hyderabad has built DAiSEE (Dataset for Affective States in E-Environments), the first multilabel video-classification dataset for recognizing boredom, confusion, frustration and engagement. The dataset comprises 9,068 video snippets captured from 112 individuals.

World's oldest Sumatran orangutan dies

• The world's oldest known critically endangered species Sumatran orangutan, Puan has died in an Australian zoo aged 62. It was described as the "grand old lady" of Perth Zoo euthanized due to agerelated complications.

Oxytocin formulations ban

• The Ministry of Health and Family Welfare has restricted the manufacture of Oxytocin formulations from 1st July 2018, no private manufacturer will be allowed to manufacture the drug for domestic use. It has also banned the import of Oxytocin and its formulations.



5.1 Inventions / Discover

First inorganic blue in 200 years

- YInMn Blue' or 'Mas blue', an inorganic blue pigment that was accidentally discovered by Professor M A 'Mas' Subramanian in the year 2009, has today become a billion-dollar product.
- YInMn Blue stands for yttrium, indium oxide and manganese. YInMn Blue is chemically stable, does
 not fade, and is non-toxic.

Two frog species discovered in Eastern and Western Ghats

• Two species of frogs have been recorded in the Indian peninsular Fejervarya kalinaga from the Eastern Ghats and Fejervarya krishnan from the Western Ghats.

New route to clean wastewater

- Self-propelling nano motors, just 200 nano metre in size, could be used for wastewater management in chemical industries.
- Developed by researchers from Indian Institute of Science Education and Research, Kolkata, and The
 Institute of Mathematical Sciences, Chennai, the nano motor can be used for transporting catalysts
 needed in harsh chemical environments and removing unwanted chemicals in water.

Novel gold nano complex for cancer drug delivery

- Using gold nano particles coated with a simple organic molecule (porphyrin), researchers from CSIR-Indian Institute of Chemical Biology, Kolkata, have designed an efficient drug nano carrier.
- The nano carrier was found to effectively deliver doxorubicin (anti-tumour drug) to the nucleus of the diseased cell and bring about programmed cell death.

Treating latent TB of the uterus improves pregnancy outcomes in infertile women

• For the first time, researchers have been able to find a direct association between latent TB of the endometrium (inner lining of the uterus) and fewer eggs in the ovary, technically called low ovarian reserve, in infertile women.



Toothpaste contribute to antibiotic resistance

• A common ingredient Triclosan, found in toothpastes and hand washes could be contributing to the rise of antibiotic resistant bacteria, a study has found.

World's first known natural manta ray nursery

 Scientists have discovered the world's first known natural manta ray nursery, located in the Gulf of Mexico which could allow them to observe the juvenile marine creatures in their habitat and learn more about them.

First ever inter-State re-introduction of tigers

• First time in the country's conservation history T-2, a three-year-old tiger from the Kanha Tiger Reserve in Madhya Pradesh introduced it to Odisha's Satkosia Tiger Reserve, marking the first ever inter-State re-introduction of tigers.

World's smallest computer device created

• Scientists have developed the world's smallest computer "Michigan Micro Mote"— a device that measures just 0.3 millimeters and could help find new ways to monitor and treat cancer.

New type of photosynthesis discovered

• The new study shows that many cyanobacteria or blue-green algae can carry out photosynthesis in the far red light or near infrared light of 750 nm. All photosynthetic organisms use chlorophyll-a for the process, but the researchers found that when cyanobacteria was grown in near- infrared light, chlorophyll a shuts down and a special chlorophyll, chlorophyll-f, performs the same task.

IISc researchers find asthma drug effective in treating TB

• A drug (Pranlukast) currently used for treating asthma has been found to be effective against tuberculosis, researchers from the Indian Institute of Science (IISc), Bengaluru, have found.



India's first robotic telescope

• India's newest telescope located at the Indian Astronomical Observatory (IAO) at Hanle in Ladakh has started observing the skies. The country's first robotic telescope observed its first light of the targeted Messier catalog – a catalog of nearby, bright astronomical sources accessible from the northern hemisphere.

World's lightest satellite to space

- Four Chennai city students build a satellite "Jai Hind 1-S" weighing 33.39 grams, probably the world's lightest and cheapest.
- It will travel to the United States next month and find a place, among other scientific material, at the Colorado Space Grant Consortium, NASA.

James Webb Space Telescope to study Jupiter's Great Red Spot: NASA

• NASA's James Webb Space Telescope, the most ambitious and complex space observatory ever built will be used to study Jupiter's Great Red Spot, shedding new light on the enigmatic storm that has been raging on the planet for over 350 years.

Novel packaging extends shelf-life of chicken

 Researcher from Bhabha Atomic Research Centre (BARC), Mumbai have developed a new ecofriendly food-packaging material using mango peel extracts and three other biodegradable polymers to extend the shelf-life of chicken.

Harpin biopesticide

 Researchers at the University of Hyderabad have found that harpin biopesticide brought about 80-90% reduction in severity of fungal infection in tomato plants when it is encapsulated in chitosan nanoparticles.



5.2 Space Science

Boost to sweet potato production

• India is joining hands with other sweet potato-producing countries in Asia and Africa in an intercontinental initiative to augment production of the root crop for food and nutritional security.

Orchid named after Narendra Modi in Singapore

 An orchid was named after Prime Minister Narendra Modi to mark his visit to the National Orchid Garden of Singapore – Dendrobium Narendra Modi.

First driving licences to women

• Saudi Arabia began issuing its first driving licences to women in decades.

Singapore re-sanctifies 148-year-old Hindu temple

- The Sri Krishnan Temple was established in 1870 in Waterloo Street, which was then known as Church Street.
- Communications and Information Minister S Iswaran and priests flown in from India led some 10,000 devotees at a ceremony to re-sanctify a 148-year old Hindu temple.

First home made anti-HIV drug

• China has approved the first domestically developed, long-acting injectable HIV drug Albuvirtide which could be a boon to tens of thousands of HIV/AIDS patients in the country.

World first EPR nuclear reactor in China

 A third generation European Pressurised Reactor (EPR) reactor in Taishan, China carried out its first nuclear chain reaction, an initial start up which is a world first for the much-delayed European technology.



Indian farmer in UAE sets world record

• An Indian farmer, Sudheesh Guruvayoor from Kerala in the UAE has set a Guinness World Record by distributing the largest number (4,914) of organic curry tree saplings in Sharjah.

Indonesia wins UNSC vote

- The Maldives failed to get elected to the UN Security Council as a non-permanent member.
- Maldives and Indonesia had contested for a seat in the UNSC, but in the plenary session held at the UN headquarters in New York, Indonesia won the seat after securing 144 votes against 46 for the Maldives.

British women celebrate 100 years of right to vote

• Thousands of women turned British cities into rivers of green, white and violet to mark 100 years since the first women won the right to vote in the U.K.

Non-permanent members of UNSC

• The UN General Assembly elected Belgium, the Dominican Republic, Germany, Indonesia and South Africa on Friday to serve as non-permanent members on the Security Council for two years starting in January.

Indian Food Festival in Berlin

- An Indian Food Festival organised at the Embassy of India saw enthusiastic participation by members of the Indian diaspora and Indian Community Associations.
- This was the second edition of the India Food Festival. The first festival was held in October 2017.

Vietnam passes cyber security law despite concerns

• vietnamese legislators have passed a contentious cybersecurity law, which critics say will hurt the economy and further restrict freedom of expression.



• The Communist Party-dominated Assembly passed the law by a majority on June 12. The law requires service providers such as Google and Facebook to store user data in Vietnam, open offices in the country and remove offending contents within 24 hours at the request of authorities.

Malaysia to reopen embassy in North Korea: PM Mahathir

 Malaysia will reopen its embassy in Pyongyang, Prime Minister Mahathir Mohamad has said, suggesting an end to the diplomatic row over the assassination of North Korean leader Kim Jong Un's half-brother in Kuala Lumpur last year.

India to host European Union Film Festival

- The European Union Film Festival (EUFF) will premiere in New Delhi on 18th June, 2018 at the Siri Fort Auditorium.
- Slovakian Movie Little Harbour to be the opening film for the festival

Incredible India road shows

• The Minister of State (Independent Charge) for Tourism, Shri K. J. Alphons will attend a series of 'Incredible India road shows' in the United States of America, from 18th to 22nd June 2018. The road shows will be held in several major cities of US including New York, Chicago & Houston.

SAARC fund to launch social enterprise programme in India

- Thimpu-based SAARC Development Fund will soon be launching a social enterprise development programme (SEDP) to fund 80 entities annually across the 8-member states including India.
- The programme will be implemented in all the SAARC member states with the objective of identifying and building social enterprises by using a mix of grants and concessional returnable capital.



Airline adopts biofuel in green push

• A brand new Cathay Pacific Airbus A350-1000 aircraft, which flew from the French city of Toulouse to Hong Kong, was partly powered by a sugarcane-based biofuel.

Canada legalises recreational cannabis use

- Canada has legalised the use of recreational marijuana nationwide, making it the first G7 country to do so.
- Uruguay became the first country to legalise the sale of cannabis for recreational use in December 2013.

U.S. pulls out of United Nations Human Rights Council

• The United States announced that it was leaving the United Nations Human Rights Council.

Mongolia Starts Construction Of Its First Oil Refinery With \$1 Billion Indian Loan

• The oil refinery, which is to come up at Altanshiree Soum in the country's Dornogobi province, has been financed by India through a \$1 billion Line of Credit extended after Prime Minister Narendra Modi visit to Mongolia in 2015.

'China proposed 2+1 format for India talks'

• Under the Chinese proposal, China and India can jointly conduct a dialogue with a third regional country in "two plus one" format for dialogue. This is different from a trilateral mechanism.

'Billion Tree Tsunami'

 Around the region of Heroshah, previously arid hills are now covered with forest as far as the horizon. In northwestern Pakistan, hundreds of millions of trees have been planted to fight deforestation across the Province of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa.



Netherlands parliament approves limited ban on burga, niqab
