5. Science and Technology

Century's longest lunar eclipse on July 27

- The longest total lunar eclipse of this century would be visible from all parts of the country on July 27.
- The celestial body would also be tinged with a reddish hue, a phenomenon popularly referred to as a blood moon.

ICAT releases First BS-VI engine certificate

• The International Centre for Automotive Technology (ICAT) has completed the first BS-VI certification for a heavy duty engine model for M/s Volvo Eicher Commercial Vehicle Limited. The engine has been developed and manufactured indigenously by Volvo Eicher in India.

IGIB find ways to reduce TB's tissue-damaging effects

• Using human macrophage, cells researchers at the Institute of Genomic and Integrative Biology (CSIR-IGIB) have shown the way to reduce TB's tissue-damaging effects.

Pigment in Goa mushroom may help fight cancer

- The mycological laboratory of the Department of Botany, Goa University reported the discovery of a new pigment from local wild mushrooms.
- New suphur-rich melanin bio-pigment of immense bio-industrial, biomedical (anti-cancer, antitumour) and biotechnological potential from local Roen alamis (wild variety of Goan mushrooms that grows on termite hills) or Termitomyces species.

IISER Pune uses nanovesicles to improve cancer drug delivery

Researchers at the Indian Institute of Science Education and Research (IISER) Pune have been able
to increase its uptake by breast cancer cells and achieve greater ability to restrict cancer cell growth
by encapsulating the poorly water-soluble anticancer drug Alisertib in polysaccharide nano-sized
balls or vesicles.



Improving the stability, bioavailability of TB FDC drug

• The physical stability and bioavailability of a fixed-dose combination (FDC) drug containing four anti-TB medicines rifampicin, isoniazid, pyrazinamide and ethambutol has been vastly improved from 3-4 days to over 30 days by turning to crystal engineering.

Kolkata Museum celebrates early tool-makers of T.N., A.P.

• One of the earliest stone tools from the region discovered by Robert Bruce Foote almost 150 years ago from various sites of Tamil Nadu and Andhra Pradesh, have been put on display for the first time at the Indian Museum in Kolkata.

AIIMS-led team develops highly sensitive, portable test for TB meningitis

• A diagnostic test for TB meningitis (the most severe form of TB) with nearly 100% sensitivity and about 91% specificity has been developed by a multi-institutional team led by Prof. Jaya Sivaswami Tyagi from the Department of Biotechnology at AIIMS.

5.1 Inventions / Discover

Cow urine can cure cancer by Gujarat team

Biotechnology scientists at Junagadh Agriculture University in Gujarat have succeeded in their first
attempt to kill cancer cells using cow urine. They claim that cow urine can cure most types of
common cancers such as those of mouth, cervix, lungs, kidney, skin and breast.

Seven new wasp species discovered in the Amazon forests

• An international team of researchers have discovered seven new wasp species belonging to the genus Clistopyga from Peru, Venezuela and Colombia.



Scientists discover the world's oldest colours

• Scientists have discovered the oldest colours in the geological record 1.1 billion-year-old bright pink pigments extracted from rocks deep beneath the Sahara desert in Africa.

IIT Bombay: Breakthrough in stem cell proliferation

 A major obstacle in using human mesenchymal stem cells (hMSCs) to treat a variety of diseases has been successfully overcome by a team of researchers at the Indian Institute of Technology (IIT) Bombay.

Silk-based bioactive wound dressing and skin graft

Researchers at the Indian Institute of Technology (IIT) Guwahati have developed bioactive wound
dressings and bio-artificial skin by using silkworm silk fibroin as matrix and coating it with
recombinant spider silk proteins.

World's First Remotely Operable Microscope

 IIT Madras Unveils World's First Remotely Operable Microscope worth Rs 40 Crore. The Atom Probe Microscopes are a kind of 3D microscopes which reconstruct the structure of an object atomby-atom.

IISc researchers find cholesterol helps bacterial toxins kill cells

• Researchers at the Indian Institute of Science (IISc), Bengaluru, have found that cholesterol present in cell membrane plays a crucial role in stabilising and binding together the pore-forming toxin cytolysin A.

World's fastest man-made spinning object developed

• Scientists have developed the fastest man-made rotor in the world, which they believe will help them study quantum mechanics. At more than 60 billion revolutions per minute, this machine is more than 100,000 times faster than a high-speed dental drill.



IISc researchers observe superconductivity at ambient temperature, pressure

• Indian Institute of Science (IISc) Bengaluru researchers have been able to achieve superconductivity at ambient temperature and pressure for the first time.

Novel biomarkers for gastric cancer progression

Researchers from University of Delhi and National Institute of Cancer Prevention and Research,
 Noida have identified two proteins survivin and STAT3 potential markers of the disease, these proteins could also be suitable therapeutic targets in preventing gastric cancer progression.

Scientists confirm Einstein's super massive black hole theory

 A team of international scientists observing a star in the Milky Way have for the first time confirmed Einstein's predictions of what happens to the motion of a star passing close to a super massive black hole.

Rare blood group 'P null' phenotype Identified

• A team of doctors, led by Shamee Shastry from the Blood Bank of Kasturba Medical College (KMC) Mangaluru, has identified a rare blood group called "pp" or "P null" phenotype.

NBRC researchers decipher how Zika virus causes microcephaly

• National Brain Research Centre-led team of researchers has successfully identified the molecular and cellular mechanisms by which Zika virus causes microcephaly.

5.2 Space Science

Astronomers capture image of a planet's birth

• Astronomers have captured the first confirmed image of a planet forming in the dust swirling around a young star. They said the planet appears as a bright spot in the snapshot taken using the European Southern Observatory's Very Large Telescope in Chile.



Cosmic rays from massive star system may reach earth

• Eta Carinae the most luminous and massive stellar system within 10,000 light-years is accelerating particles to high energies, some of which may reach the earth as cosmic rays, a study using data from a NASA telescope has found.

Flight testing of Crew Escape System – Technology Demonstrator

- ISRO carried out a major technology demonstration, the first in a series of tests to qualify a Crew Escape System, which is a critical technology relevant for human spaceflight.
- The Crew Escape System is an emergency escape measure designed to quickly pull the crew module along with the astronauts to a safe distance from the launch vehicle in the event of a launch abort.

ISRO's li-ion cell tech has many takers

• The Indian Space Research Organization's (ISRO) move to transfer indigenous technology for manufacture of lithium-ion battery has received an overwhelming response from industry, according to the space agency.

NASA to launch probe into sun's scorching atmosphere

NASA is preparing to send the Parker Solar Probe, a robotic spacecraft the size of a small car closer
to the sun, enduring wicked heat while zooming through the solar corona to study this outermost part
of the stellar atmosphere that gives rise to the solar wind.

Underground lake detected on Mars

- Using a radar instrument on an orbiting spacecraft, scientists have spotted salt-laden lake under ice on the southern polar plain of Mars, a body of water they called a possible habitat for microbial life.
- It is the first stable body of liquid water ever found on Mars.



ISRO ropes in three partners to assemble 27 satellites

• The Indian Space Research Organization (ISRO) has roped in three partners to help it assemble 27 satellites at a quick pace over the next three years.

Mars will be at its closest point to Earth

• On July 31, Mars will be at its closest point to Earth in 15 years. It will be at a distance of around 57.6 million km from Earth, which is the closest since 2003 when it came within 55.7 million km of Earth.

First women to join nuclear-powered fleet crew

• France has become just the third country to bring women onboard its nuclear-powered subs, which operate much longer and isolated missions than traditional vessels, after the U.S. and Britain.

Japanese start-up to deliver 'meteor showers' on demand

• A Japanese start-up developing "shooting stars on demand" says it will be ready to deliver the world's first artificial meteor shower in a spectacular show over Hiroshima in early 2020.



Expansion of Emergency Ambulance Service

• The Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi, delivered an address over live video link, on the occasion of the expansion of Emergency Ambulance Service over the entire island in Sri Lanka, with Indian Assistance.

China offers fresh grant of \$295 mn to Sri Lanka

• Chinese President Xi Jinping has offered Sri Lanka a fresh grant of two billion yuan (\$295 million), as Beijing tries to expand its influence in the island-nation.

UN urges Myanmar to create conditions for Rohingya return

• The UN Security Council has urged Myanmar's government to step-up efforts to create conditions that will allow Rohingya Muslims who fled a violent crackdown to safely return to the country from neighbouring Bangladesh.

Prime Minister addressed the Ugandan Parliament

• Prime Minister Narendra Modi arrived in Uganda's capital Kampala as part of a two-day visit to the country – the first bilateral tour by an Indian prime minister since 1997.

Imran Khan declares victory in Pakistan election

• Pakistan's cricket star-turned politician Imran Khan declared victory for his party, the Pakistan Tehreek-e-Insaf party (PTI), in the country's general election.

Imran Khan wins in Pakistan election but needs coalition to become PM

 Pakistan's Election Commission declared former cricket star Imran Khan's party the winner of Pakistan's historic third consecutive election of a civilian government, but he didn't win an outright majority and must form a coalition.



World's oldest person dies at 117

• The world's oldest person Chiyo Miyako, a 117-year-old Japanese woman, has died.

 Prime Minister Narendra Modi met South African President Cyril Ramaphosa and to expand the bilateral ties in a number of sectors, including trade and investment, information technology and defence.

Imran Khan to be sworn in as Pakistan PM

India to give flash flood warning to Asian nations

 India has been designated as a nodal centre for preparing flash-flood forecasts that can issue advance warning of floods in Vietnam, Sri Lanka, Myanmar and Thailand by the World Meteorological Organization (WMO).
