NITI Aayog and IBM signed a Statement of Intent (SoI) today to develop a crop yield prediction
model using Artificial Intelligence (AI) to provide real time advisory to farmers in Aspirational
Districts.

NMDC, NLC to ink R&D pact

- NMDC Limited and NLC India Limited (formerly Neyveli Lignite Corporation) may invest over
 USD 26 million for setting up an R&D facility with Australian Environmental Clean
 Technologies (ECT) Limited for developing innovative technologies in iron and steel making.
- The project is aimed at diversifying the use of lignite (brown coal) in the generation of electricity and production of steel at lower cost with significantly lower CO2 emissions.

Reliance Power quits Tilaiya project

• Reliance Power Limited has pulled out of the special purpose vehicle set up to develop an ultra mega power project at Tilaiya in Jharkhand.

NTPC inks pact with Bihar

• NTPC inked a pact with Bihar and its power utilities to acquire their entire stake in two joint ventures at Nabinagar and Kanti, and to buy Barauni thermal plant.

Kerala and NTPC sign MoU for increasing solar power generation

- The Kerala State Electricity Board has signed a memorandum of understanding with the National Thermal Power Corporation for increasing solar power generation in the state.
- The MoU also includes an agreement to set up a 15 MW solar power unit at the NTPC complex in Kayamkulam.



Maharashtra signs MoU with GRIHA council for green buildings

- Maharashtra government the first state to sign an MoU with the Centers Green Rating for Integrated Habitat Assessment (GRIHA) Council to train state PWD officials to rate government buildings.
- To construct government complexes as green buildings this would minimize the use of electricity while optimizing the use of natural light and non-conventional energy.

NITI Aayog and Google sign SoI to help grow AI ecosystem in India

Aiming to foster growth for India's nascent artificial intelligence (AI) and machine learning (ML)
ecosystem, NITI Aayog and Google have come together to work on a range of initiatives to help
build the AI ecosystem across the country.

SIDBI to extend direct funding facility to Village Level Entrepreneurs (VLEs) in CSCs

• CSC SPV (Special purpose vehicle) and Small Industries Development Bank of India (SIDBI) signed an MoU for providing financial support to Common Services Centers (CSCs) across the country, with minimum one year of operation, under the Direct Financing Window of SIDBI.

Haryana signs 2 MoUs for revival of Sarasvati

 Memorandums of understanding (MoUs) for investigation into the palaeochannel and the study of hydrological aspects relating to the Sarasvati rejuvenation and heritage development projects.

IIT-M inks pact with AAI for research in air navigation systems

The Indian Institute of Technology – Madras has signed an MoU with the Airports Authority of India
(AAI) for research on air navigation systems & will address aviation infrastructure and air traffic
management challenges across 125 airports in the country.



MOU to develop prototypes for self-piloted vertical take-off and landing (VTOL) aircraft

- IIT-Kanpur to develop vertical take-off and landing aircraft prototypes
- The VTOL technology equips the aircraft to perform manoeuvres that are impossible with traditional aircraft, and also comes across as a big advantage for air combat and rescue.

Tata Trusts signs MoU with govt to provide development support in Naxal-hit districts

 The Tata Trusts has joined hands with the government to help it in development initiatives in eight worst Naxal-affected districts in Chhattisgarh, which were covered under the "transformation of aspirational" districts programme.

Ministry of Women and Child Development signs an MoU with Government of Uttar Pradesh

• The Ministry of Women and Child and Development, Government of India has signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with Department of Women and Child Development, Government of Uttar Pradesh, in New Delhi for management of Home of Widows at Sunrakh Bangar, Vrindavan. The Ministry of Women and Child Development has constructed this shelter home for widows with a capacity of 1000 inmates.
