- The Assam Assembly has passed an amendment in the GST Act by exempting GST registration for companies having up to 20 lakh rupees turnover per annum.
- Punjab Cabinet approved a policy for regularization of unauthorized colonies developed before March 19, 2018.
- Maharashtra government brought in 31 reforms in the state GST structure to promote ease of doing business.
- Insolvency and Bankruptcy Board of India (IBBI) celebrated its Annual Day
- Bangladesh abolished a controversial quota system for civil service jobs.
