- Alphonso from Ratnagiri, Sindhudurg, Palghar, Thane and Raigad districts of Maharashtra, is registered as Geographical Indication (GI).
- The Southern Railway has said it has become Unmanned Level Crossing (UMLC) Free Zone, eliminating over 1,000 such level crossings.
- NASA's Parker Solar Probe mankind's first mission to 'touch' the Sun successfully completed a flyby of Venus.
- Drug firm Zydus Cadila has received approval from the US Food and Drug Administration (USFDA) to market Exemestane tablets, used for treatment of breast cancer.
- The Commonwealth Parliamentary Conference of Indian Region will begin in Guwahati.
- President of India Ram Nath Kovind addressed an International Conference on Women's Health, Wellness and Empowerment in Kanpur, Uttar Pradesh.
- Justice Surva Kant Chief Justice of the Himachal Pradesh High Court
- Pankaj Sharma India's Ambassador to UN Conference on Disarmament
