- World Diabetes Day (WDD) was created in 1991 by IDF and the World Health Organization in response to growing concerns about the escalating health threat posed by diabetes. It is marked every year on 14 November, the birthday of Sir Frederick Banting, who co-discovered insulin along with Charles Best in 1922.
- The Theme for World Diabetes Day 2018-19 is Family and Diabetes.

ISRO successfully launches communication satellite GSAT-29

• ISRO's heavy-lift rocket GSLV-MkIII-D2 blasted off from Sriharikota on November 14 carrying India's latest communication satellite GSAT-29 on



board. GSLV-MkIII-D2 rocket successfully injects the satellite into a geosynchronous transfer orbit.
