- The Maldives cabinet has approved to rejoin the Commonwealth, two years after withdrawing from the 53-nation grouping.
- British PM wins business support for draft Brexit deal.
- RBI to set up expert panel to look into issues on capital surplus.
- The Prime Minister of India launched a Grand Challenge on resolving seven identified Ease of Doing Business problems.
- 27th BASIC Ministerial Meeting on Climate Change held in the historic city of Delhi.
- BASIC (Brazil, South Africa, India and China) Countries, being hosted by MoEFCC in New Delhi.
- The Minister of State for Home Affairs Shri Kiren Rijiju inaugurated the workshop on 'Role of Media in Disaster Management', in New Delhi.
