- Land acquisition process for the 9900 MegaWatt nuclear power plant in Jaitapur in Maharashtra has been completed.
- Kartik Purnima is being celebrated in Odisha as the culmination of hindu holy month of Kartik.
- Government of India has decided to mark the remembrance of 100 years of the historical Jallianwalla Bagh Massacre next year.
- Road Transport and Highways Ministry has notified the ion of the item Quadricycle as a non-transport vehicle under the Motor Vehicles Act 1988.
- A seven-member central team has reached Chennai for on-the-spot assessment of the damage caused by Cyclone Gaja in Tamil Nadu.
- The population of China's capital, Beijing, declined for the first time in two decades in 2017.
