8. Modalities

(i) Preliminary Scrutiny has been done on the basis of scrutiny report generated by the ORA System and the information furnished by the candidates in their online applications.

(ii) Total relevant experience of practicing criminal/fiscal law in a court /bar as per the provisions of recruitment rules as claimed by the candidates has been taken into consideration, if supported by necessary certificates. Teaching Experience and other experiences of working in Supervisory capacity in office, Public Sector Undertakings, Banks, etc. have not been considered as relevant.

(iii) In the case candidates who do not possess the relevant essential educational qualification have been rejected as “LEQ-A”. Like-wise, if experience is not in the relevant field as specified in Recruitment Rules and advertisement of the post or experience is less than the required period, such candidates have been rejected under “LEQ-B”.

(iv) Experience possessed in the relevant fields specified in the advertisement, after obtaining/qualifying the essential Educational Qualification i.e. LLB or LLM, has been counted. For example if LLB is taken as essential qualification than the experience after completion of LLB degree has been counted and if LLM is taken as essential qualification than experience after completion of LLM degree has been counted for taking into consideration. Further, candidates shortlisted have to necessarily fulfill either of the criteria i.e. required number of years of post qualification experience after acquiring LLB or after LLM as prescribed for their respective category.

(v) Experience Certificate is required to be uploaded/ available to ascertain the eligibility of the candidate. Those, candidates who have submitted part experience certificate, he/she has been called for interview provisionally subject to production of complete / fresh experience certificate for entire period as claimed in online application.

(vi) Appointment Letters, Office Orders, Resignation Letters, Relieving Orders, pay certificates and self employment certificates have not been considered as proof of experience.

(vii) Experience certificates should be in prescribed proforma in terms of Commission's circular No.F.8/84/2010-R(C&P) dated 23.12.2010. However, wherever the applicants have not submitted experience certificates in prescribed proforma, their experience certificates have been considered on merit.

(viii) As the number of applications received is very large, fixing a higher requirement in terms of experience for shortlisting the candidates has been considered necessary. Therefore, the requisite experience in the relevant field as specified in the advertisement has been raised to 15 years in case the essential qualification is LLB and 13 years in case the essential qualification is LLM. The relevant experience has to be post qualification in both the cases and the experience should be of practicing criminal/fiscal case in the court of Law. The aforesaid criteria has been raised for candidates belonging to the categories of UR, OBC & SC. However, during the course of shortlisting of applications it was observed that after adopting the aforesaid criteria, the sufficient number of eligible PH candidates were not available in the zone of consideration. Therefore, in case of PH candidates, the criteria of requisite experience has been lowered to 13 years in case of LLB and 11 years in case of LLM. Experience in both the cases has been considered for post qualification period only.
