- The Ministry of Tourism have formulated the guidelines for approval and reapproval of Online Travel Aggregators OTA.
- Japanese government enacted a new law to bring more blue-collar foreign workers into the country to address chronic labour shortages.
- Massachusetts Institute of Technology (MIT) scientists in the U.S. have designed a system that could store renewable energy, such as solar and wind power, and deliver it back into an electric grid on demand.
- NASA's InSight lander provided the first-ever "sounds" of Martian wind on the Red Planet.
- Google announces 'Journalism AI' project.
- OPEC & its allies agree to cut oil output.
