

**THE LODHI DYNASTY (1451-1526)****Bahlul Lodhi (1451-1488)**

Bahlul Lodhi was an Afghan who established himself in Punjab after the invasion of Timur. He founded the Lodhi dynasty.

**Sikander Lodhi (1489-1517)**

Sikander Lodhi was the son of Bahlul Lodhi. He moved his capital from Bihar and western Bengal and transferred his capital, Delhi to Agra.

**Ibrahim Lodhi (1517-1526)**

He was the last king of the Lodhi dynasty and the last sultan of Delhi. He was the son of Sikander Lodhi. His uncle Alam Khan, who was, a pretender to the throne, invited Babur to invade India. The First Battle of Panipat was fought on 21 April 1526 between Ibrahim Lodhi, the Sultan of Delhi, and Zahir-ud-din Muhammad Babur, the ruler of Kabul. Babur defeated Lodhi and established the Mughal dynasty.
