- Andhra Pradesh's second largest petroglyph site, containing about 80 petroglyhs, has been discovered at Mekala Benchi in Kurnool district.
- Prime Minister Modi laid foundation stone of revival of six irrigation projects, including North Koel (Mandal Dam) project in Jharkhand.
- A special court in Mumbai declared absconding liquor baron Vijay Mallya a fugitive economic offender (FEO) on a plea of the Enforcement Directorate.
- Mallya has become the first businessman to be declared an FEO under the provisions of the new Fugitive Economic Offenders Act.
- The National Green Tribunal has imposed a fine of 100 crore rupees on Meghalaya government for its failure to curb illegal coal mining in the state.
