Mega Food Parks

- The Scheme aims at providing a mechanism to link agricultural production to the market by bringing together farmers, processors and retailers
- The food parks aims to ensure maximizing value addition, minimizing wastage, increasing farmers' income and creating employment opportunities particularly in rural sector.
- It is based on "Cluster" approach and envisages a well-defined processing zone containing state-ofthe art processing facilities with support infrastructure and well-established supply chain.
- Pattern of Assistance -
- 1. **In General areas -** One time capital grant of 50% of the project cost subject to a maximum of Rs.50 crore
- 2. **In Hilly & Difficult terrain -** Capital grant of 75% of the project cost subject to a maximum of Rs. 50 crore

Pradhan Mantri Kisan Sampada Yojana

- It is a Central Sector Scheme that aims to supplement agriculture, modernize processing and decrease Agriculture waste.
- It was previously known as Scheme for Agro-Marine Processing and Development of Agro-Processing Clusters (SAMPADA).
- The following schemes will be implemented under it
- 1. Mega Food Parks
- 2. Integrated Cold Chain and Value Addition Infrastructure
- 3. Creation/ Expansion of Food Processing/ Preservation Capacities (Unit Scheme)
- 4. Infrastructure for Agro-processing Clusters
- 5. Creation of Backward and Forward Linkages
- 6. Food Safety and Quality Assurance Infrastructure
- 7. Human Resources and Institutions
