- Maharashtra's election commission has launched a voter awareness campaign in the upcoming Lok Sabha polls.
- Prime Minister flagged off an1st ever indigenously developed electric locomotive converted from a diesel engine at the Diesel Locomotives Works (DLW) Varanasi.
- Myanmar set up a committee to discuss reforming the country's military-drafted constitution.
- Israelis to launch its first moon mission this week, sending an unmanned (Genesis) spacecraft to collect data to be shared with NASA.
- RBI to give Rs 28,000 cr to Centre as dividend.
- Union Minister Nitin Gadkari will launch the revised guidelines for chartering of ships in Mumbai at the Regional Maritime Safety Conference.

- The Home Minister launched two portals Investigation Tracking System for Sexual Offences and Safe City Implementation Monitoring Portal.
- A separate Women Safety Division has been established in the Home Ministry and many existing laws have been amended.
