- Governor of Mizoram Kummanam Rajasekharan has resigned from his post.
- President Ram Nath Kovind has appointed Prof. Jagdish Mukhi as the Governor of Mizoram, in addition to his own duties of Assam Governor.
- Thirty-six countries have signed an open letter criticising Saudi Arabia's human rights record.
- NATO Chief rules out nuclear missile deployment to Europe.
- Prime Minister Narendra Modi, attended the National Women Livelihood Meet-2019 held at Varanasi, Uttar Pradesh, on International Women's Day.
- Union Minister Suresh Prabhu was addressing a National Seminar on procurement and marketing support to MSMEs and the launch of Womennnovators in New Delhi.
- Ausaf Sayeed New Ambassador of India to Saudi Arabia
- Padma Lakshmi UNDP's Goodwill Ambassador
