- 1. May 18 World AIDS Vaccine Day, 1998 to commemorate the anniversary of Clinton's speech.
- 2. May 18 International Museum Day, 2019 Theme "Museums as Cultural Hubs: The future of tradition".
- 3. In Kerala, Roshni project to cover 40 schools this academic year
- 4. A first such facility in the public sector, Kilo Lab was opened at the CSIR-Indian Institute of Chemical Technology (IICT) in Hyderabad.
- 5. IIT-D signs MoU with Taiwanese university to establish and offer a Joint Doctoral Degree Programme to students who work together and carry out joint research.
