- 1. May 11 World Migratory Bird Day 2019, 2019 Theme Protect Birds: Be the Solution to Plastic Pollution
- 2. PepsiCo withdraws all cases against potato farmers
- 3. Airports Authority of India (AAI) started the process of taking over offices of Jet Airways at various airports, along with cancelling Airport Entry Passes of employees.
- 4. Supreme Court-appointed mediation committee time till August 15 to continue with its efforts to resolve the prolonged and strife-ridden Ayodhya title dispute.
- A WTO Ministerial meeting of developing countries is being hosted by India in New Delhi on 13-14 May 2019.
- 6. Justice Oka took over the helm of the Karnataka High Court from Acting Chief Justice Lingappa Narayana Swamy.
- 7. Chandrayaan-2, the lunar lander mission planned to be launched during July 9-16, will have 14 Indian payloads or study devices.
