Triple Talaq Bill passed in Lok Sabha

The Lok Sabha passed the Muslim Women (Protection of Rights on Marriage), Bill, 2019
commonly known as Triple Talaq bill by voice vote. Law minister Ravi Shankar Prasad
said it was important to bring in a law banning instant triple talaq as the practice has
continued despite a Supreme Court verdict passed in 2017.
