July 28 - World hepatitis day

World Hepatitis Day is observed on 28 July. The date of 28 July was chosen because it is
the birthday of Nobel-prize winning scientist Dr Baruch Blumberg, who discovered
hepatitis B virus (HBV) and developed a diagnostic test and vaccine for the virus.

July 28 - World Nature Conservation day

• World Nature Conservation day is celebrated on July 28 across the world in order to raise awareness about protecting nature and conserving our natural resources.

July 29 – Global Tiger Day

• Global Tiger Day, takes place annually on July 29. It is a day to celebrate tigers, to raise awareness for the need for their preservation, and to promote the protection and expansion of their habitats. The day was designated in the St. Petersburg Declaration on Tiger Conservation, which was released on November 23, 2010, during the Global Tiger Summit.

Fourth cycle of All India Tiger Estimation – 2018

• The Tiger Estimation exercise is believed to be the world's largest wildlife survey effort in terms of coverage, intensity of sampling and quantum of camera trapping. India conducts the All India Tiger Estimation every four years. Three cycles of the estimation have already been completed in 2006, 2010 and 2014.
