RBI relaxes External Commercial Borrowing norms for corporates, non-banking lenders

This will be applicable to External Commercial Borrowing (ECBs) taken for working capital, general corporate purpose loans or repayment of rupee loans.

 Parliament has passed the Companies (Amendment) Bill, 2019. The Bill seeks to amend the Companies Act, 2013. It aims to tighten Corporate Social Responsibility-CSR compliance, transfer certain responsibilities to National Company Law Tribunal and recategorise certain offences as civil offences.

His Urine sample was subsequently tested and found to contain Terbutaline. Terbutaline, a specified substance, is prohibited both In & Out of Competition in the WADA Prohibited List of Substances.
