Government to start special hospitals offering Indian system of medicines

Typhoon Lekima

• In China, the death toll from Typhoon Lekima in the eastern part of the country has risen to 32. Lekima had crossed into Jiangsu province north of Shanghai and was expected to hit Shandong province later today.

ISRO says Chandrayaan-2 to move towards moon

• Indian Space Research Organisation chairman Dr K Sivan has said, the organization on August 14 will perform a maneuvers called trans-lunar injection by which Chandrayaan 2 will leave earth and move towards the moon's orbit. The ISRO Chairmans said, the spacecraft will be reaching the moon's orbit on 20th of this month and it will be landing on the moon's surface on 7th of next month by performing a series of maneuvers.

Low-cost handheld device to help detect bacteria developed

• Researchers at the Indian Institute of Technology - Guwahati (IIT-G) have developed a low-cost handheld biocompatible sensor that can detect bacteria almost instantaneously without cell culture and microbiological assays.
