## Bangladesh Cricket Board name Domingo as new national coach

 The Bangladesh Cricket Board appointed former South African Coach Russel Domingo as the Head Coach for the national cricket team. This was announced in Dhaka by BCB President Nazmul Hasan.

#### Pradhan Mantri Laghu Vyapari Maan-Dhan scheme

- The Pradhan Mantri Laghu Vyapari Maan-Dhan scheme would target enrolling 25 lakh subscribers in 2019-2020 and 2 crore by 2023-2024. Apart from an online portal that would be launched, people would be able to apply for the scheme through the common service centres already in place for other schemes.
- Traders aged between 18 and 40 who have an annual turnover of less than □ 1.5 crore are eligible. The subscribers will have to contribute a monthly amount, which will vary depending on the age at which they enter the scheme, that will be matched by the government. Upon turning 60, the subscribers will get □ 3,000 as monthly pension.
