- **August 15 - 73rd Independence Day**
- Jal Shakti Minister Shri Gajendra Singh Shekhawat launched the Swachh Survekshan Grameen 2019 (SSG 2019) in Delhi.
- The government will launch a Jal Jeevan Mission to bring piped water to households and resolved to spend more than Rs.3.5 lakh crore in coming years.
- An unexploded World War II bomb was found in the grounds of the Kremlin in Moscow during construction works.
- . Pretomanid is the novel compound developed by the New York-based non-profit organisation TB Alliance and which received the FDA greenlight.
- July 2019 was the joint-hottest month on Earth (July 2016 was equally hot), according to the United Nations.
- Minister of Railways and Commerce & Industry, Shri Piyush Goyal launched CORAS (Commando for Railway Security) of Indian Railways and new establishment manual for Railway Protection Force.
