 World mosquito day is celebrated annually on August 20. It is a commemoration of a British doctor, Sir Ronald Ross's discovery in 1897 that 'female mosquitoes transmit malaria between humans'. The London School of Hygiene and Tropical Medicine organizes world mosquito day celebrations every year, since the 1930s.

Chandrayaan-2 moon mission ready to enter lunar orbit today

• Indian Space Research Organisation Chairman Dr. K Sivan has informed that Chandrayaan-2 moon mission will have lunar orbit ion at around 9.30 am. The liquid engine onboard the spacecraft will be fired to slow down the spacecraft until Moon's gravity captures it. Chandrayaan 2 was launched on July 22 by GSLV Mark III-M1 launch vehicle and after around 29 days, its ion into lunar orbit today will be considered as another milestone for ISRO
