- 12 September International Day for South-South Cooperation
- The Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi launched Swachhata Hi Seva (SHS) 2019, a massive countrywide awareness and mobilization campaign on Swachhata at Mathura.
- India's tallest Air Traffic Control tower was inaugurated at the Indira Gandhi International Airport recently.
- The famous Srivilliputtur palkova, a sweet made from cow milk and sugar got the Geographical Indication (GI) tag from the Geographical Indications Registry in Chennai.
- A "Prachar Rath", flagged off by Agriculture Minister Lal Chand Kataria, in Rajasthan.
- India-Poland direct flight to be launched on September 12 and the flight will be operated by LOT Polish Airlines.
- Union Minister of State for Home Affairs, Shri G. Kishan Reddy to inaugurate the National Conference on "Criminal Activities and Radicalization in Jails: Vulnerability of Inmates and Jail Staff and their Protection" on September 12, 2019.
- Government e Marketplace (GeM) under the Department of Commerce, Ministry of Commerce & Industry and Government of Punjab, signed MoU to set up a GeM Organizational Transformation Team (GOTT) Project Management Unit (PMU) in the state.
