- Hindi Divas is being celebrated across the country.
- Union Minister for Communications, Electronics & Information Technology and Law & Justice Shri Ravi Shankar Prasad has launched the maritime communication services at Mumbai.
- Union Minister for Tribal Affairs Shri Arjun Munda launched the Biggest Tribal movement to promote tribal enterprise through Bamboonomics in the country which will be a beacon for the rest of the world.
- Union Government has set a target of setting up 12 thousand 500 Ayush Health and Wellness Centres across the country.
- Bangladesh is holding talks with neighbouring countries including India to import electricity and invest in power plants to make electricity available to every village in the country.
- The government has imposed a minimum onion export price of 850 US dollars per tonne to curb its exports and help bring down domestic prices.
- Union Minister of State for Food Processing Industries Rameswar Teli has said, the World Bank will provide three thousand crore rupees assistance to finance, mini and mega food parks across the country.
- 15th Indo-US Economic Summit was organised by the Indo-American Chamber of Commerce- North India Council (IACC- NIC) in New Delhi.
- Indian Railways signed a Memorandum of Understanding with Confederation of Indian Industries in New Delhi for the facilitation of green initiatives.
- Five Indian women police officers were honoured by the United Nations for their commendable services in UN mission in South Sudan.
- In Hockey Rani Rampal was named the captain of the 18-member Indian Women's team which will take on England in a five-match series.
