October 6 - World Cerebral Palsy Day

World Cerebral Palsy Day (WCPY) is observed on 6th October. Cerebral palsy refers to a
group of neurological disorders that appear in infancy or early childhood and
permanently affect body movement and muscle coordination. The project was launched in
2012 by Cerebral Palsy Alliance (Australia) and United Cerebral Palsy (USA).
