- **October 02 – International Day of Non-Violence**
- Mohandas Karamchand Gandhi a political ethicist who employed nonviolent resistance to lead the successful campaign for India’s independence from British Rule was born on October 2, 1869.
- The nation is remembering Former Prime Minister Lal Bahadur Shastri on his birth anniversary.
- The Minister of Petroleum & Natural Gas and Minister of Steel, Shri Dharmendra Pradhan inaugurated the nationwide “Paryatan Parv 2019” in New Delhi.
- Telangana has become one of the fully electrified states in the country after providing electricity to over 5 lakh 15 thousand households under the Soubhagya Yojana introduced by the Centre in October 2017.
- China celebrated its 70th anniversary of the founding of the People’s Republic of China (PRC) with a massive military parade, showcasing its most advanced weapons.
- On the eve of Gandhi Jayanti “Khadi Nepal” fashion show ensembling Khadi and handloom couture from India and Nepal was held in Kathmandu.
- The government of Uzbekistan has issued a special postage stamp to mark the 150th birth anniversary of Mahatma Gandhi.
- Russia will next month celebrate the life of Kalashnikov, designer of the AK-47, with a number of events, including the museum display and a biopic.
- The International Astronomical Union (IAU) has named an asteroid, discovered in 2006, after Indian classical singer Pandit Jasraj.
- The Documentation Identification Number (DIN) system of Central Board of Direct Taxes (CBDT) has come into existence from with the generation of about 17,500 communications with DIN on the very first day.
- The 94th Raising Day of the Military Nursing Service (MNS) was celebrated on October 1.

- The Appointments Committee of the Cabinet has approved the appointment of Shri Pradipta Kumar Bisoi to the post of Secretary, Department of Posts.
- Air Marshal Harjit Singh Arora took over as Vice Chief of the Air Staff. The Air Marshal was commissioned in the Indian Air Force as a fighter pilot in Dec 1981.
- Former Sri Lanka captain Kumar Sangakkara took over as the first non-British President of the historic Marylebone Cricket Club (MCC) .
