Bihar Agricultural University, Sabour invites online applications from eligible candidates to fill-up 24 (twenty four) Backlog vacancies of Extremely Backward Class (EBC) for the post of Assistant Professor-cum-Junior Scientist / Junior Scientist-cum-Assistant Professor on direct recruitment basis. Eligible candidates may fill-up the application through online mode by visiting university website www.bausabour.ac.in. Candidates working in Govt./Semi Govt./Public Sector Undertaking / Autonomous Institutions etc. are required to submit applications through proper channel. However, they must submit advance copy with requisite fee within stipulated time. Only eligible candidates will be called for interview. The details of vacancies are as below:

APPLICATION FEE:-

The application fee of Rs. 1000/- (Rs. 250/- in case of female candidate) is to be paid only through the payment gateway by online Internet Banking / Debit Card / Credit Card.

ESSENTIAL QUALIFICATION :-

- i. Good academic record with at least 55% of the marks or an equivalent grade of B in the 7 point scale with letter grades O,A,B,C,D,E and F at the Master's degree level, in the relevant subject from an Indian University, or, an equivalent degree from a foreign University.
- ii. NET shall remain compulsory alongwith one publication in NAAS (National Academy of Agricultural Sciences, New Delhi) rated refereed journal for recruitment to the post of Assistant Professor and equivalent in the disciplines in which NET is conducted.

Essentiality of NET can be waived off for the candidates holding Ph.D. degree provided it has been done with course work as prescribed by the UGC Regulations, 2009 and the candidate has at least two full length publications having a NAAS rating not less than 4, on the last date of submission of application.

Those candidates with Ph.D. degree without course work will not qualify for NET exemption."

A relaxation of 5% may be provided from 55% to 50% of the marks to the Ph.D. Degree holders who have passed their Masters' Degree prior to 19th Sept., 1991

- iii. Ph.D. if available shall be preferred.

Note:-

For appointment on the posts of teachers/scientist in Agriculture, Veterinary, Ag. Engg., related subject, it would be a basic requirement for the candidate applying for the posts to hold / possess respective basic professional degree at the Under-graduate level.

Professional Degree means; B.Sc. (Agriculture) / B.Tech (Ag. Engg.) or equivalent and Pure Science for Basic Sciences subjects.

MAXIMUM AGE LIMIT :-

- i. Maximum age as per Resolution No. 294 dated 07.01.2016 issued by General Administration Department, Govt. of Bihar, Patna is 40 years.
- ii. There will be no age restriction for employees of Bihar Agricultural University, Sabour seeking higher posts under direct recruitment procedures.

RESERVATION :-

- i. Reservation shall only be applicable to the original resident of Bihar State as per reservation rule of State Govt.
- ii. Candidates seeking employment against Backlog vacancies of Extremely Backward Class (EBC) must submit caste/category certificate issued by the competent authority as per the rules of Bihar Government.

3. The University shall not be responsible under any circumstances for any sort of postal delay.
4. Persons already in employment should apply **Through Proper Channel** and must produce **NOC-cum-Vigilance Clearance Certificate** from their present employer at the time of interview in prescribed performa annexed as **Schedule-II**.

SELECTION PROCESS :-

Academic Qualification, Experience, Recognition/Awards/Special Attainments, Publications and Extra-curricular activities shall carry 80 marks and Interview shall carry 20 marks. The summary of marks distribution is given below:

In the event of total marks obtained by two or more candidates is same, the candidate having higher cumulative marks under Sl.No. 1 (Academic Qualification) of the evaluation criteria as above will be placed higher in the final merit list. Subsequently, in the event of candidate having same cumulative marks under Sl.No. 1 (Academic Qualification) of the evaluation criteria, candidates who are elder in age according to the date of birth will be placed higher in the final merit list and in the event of candidates having same date of birth, candidates whose name appear alphabetically first in Devnagiri Script will be placed higher in the final merit list.


GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS :-

1. The candidates are required to apply only through **ONLINE** mode. **Application filled-up through any other mode will NOT be entertained.**
2. Before filling-up the Online Application Form, the candidates are advised to read General Instructions, Essential Qualification and Other Important Conditions carefully.
3. Fee once paid will not be refunded under any circumstances.
4. Separate application alongwith application fee should be submitted for each post applied for.
5. The University reserves the right to:
 - a. withdraw the advertisement either partly or wholly at any time without assigning any reason to this effect.
 - b. fill or not to fill up some or all the posts advertised for any reasons whatsoever.
 - c. increase/decrease the number of posts at the time of selection and make appointments accordingly.
 - d. alter/insert any corrections/additions in the advertisement/website in the event of any error / or otherwise before the last date prescribed for the receipt of applications

- e. the selection committee may decide its own method of evaluating the performance of the candidates in interview.
6. It shall be the responsibility of the candidate to assess his/her own eligibility for the post for which he/she is applying in accordance with the prescribed qualifications, experience and submit the application duly filled-in, along with the desired information and documents as per the advertisement. Suppression of factual information, supply of fake documents, providing false or misleading information or canvassing in any manner on the part of the candidates shall lead to his disqualification. In case, it is detected at any point of time in future, even after appointment, that the candidate was not eligible, appointment of the candidate shall be liable to be terminated forthwith as per this clause and other legal action will be taken.
 7. Incomplete applications or without relevant supporting enclosures (self-attested copies of degree/certificates/marks sheets/experience certificate, etc.) will be out-rightly rejected.
 8. Consequent upon adoption of self-certification provisions, the University shall process the applications entirely on the basis of information / documents submitted by the candidates. In case the information/ documents are found to be false /incorrect by way of omission or commission, the responsibility and liability shall lie solely with the candidate.
 9. No interim correspondence shall be entertained.
 10. The list of eligible candidates for interview or any other information related to date, time and venue of interview shall be uploaded on the University website i.e. www.bausabour.ac.in.
 11. The person appointed against any post shall be governed by the act/statutes/rules and regulation of the University as framed and amended from time to time.
 12. The service conditions including pay level and age of superannuation shall be as per University rules.
 13. Information uploaded on the University website shall not be provided to the candidate under RTI Act, 2005. The uploaded information on the University website shall remain for a specific period only. Therefore, the candidates are advised to download the information and preserve them for future reference. In midway of recruitment process neither any application under Right to Information Act, 2005 shall be entertained nor information shall be provided. Factual information under RTI Act shall be provided only after declaration of final results. Reply to inferential (speculative) questions shall not be provided.

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14. In case of any inadvertent mistake in the process of selection, which may be detected at any stage even after issue of the appointment letter, the University reserves the right to modify/withdraw/cancel any communication made to the candidates.
15. The University shall not be responsible for any misplacement, omission etc. if two or more applications are put in one cover (envelop) by the candidate.
16. **Recognised Institutions:** Candidates, who have obtained degrees or diplomas or certificates for various courses from institution not recognised by the University Grants Commission, New Delhi shall not be eligible for the posts advertised.
17. Regarding any ambiguity or lack of clarity in any clause or rules, the decision of the University shall remain final.
18. In case of any disputes, any suites or legal proceedings against the University, the territorial jurisdiction shall be restricted to the Courts in Bihar at District Court Bhagalpur and High Court, Patna.
19. Advance copy of application form may be considered subject to production of NOC/ Vigilance Clearance Certificate from Employer at the time of interview.
20. New pension scheme will be applicable with subsequent amendments to fresh regular recruited persons.
21. Candidates shall have to produce original certificates/ documents at the time of interview. In the absence of the same, respective document not be considered for evaluation of candidate.
