RBI mandates linking new loans to medium enterprises to external benchmark

With an aim to strengthen monetary policy transmission, RBI said that all new floating rate loans to the medium enterprises would be linked to the external benchmarks. The fresh loans extended by banks to medium enterprises from April 1, 2020, would be linked to the benchmarks.

The RBI linked all new floating rate personal or retail loans (housing, auto, etc.) and floating rate loans to Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) extended by banks with effect from October 1, 2019, to external benchmarks.

India surpasses France, UK to become world's 5th largest economy: IMF



India became world's fifth largest economy in 2019 in terms of nominal GDP, leapfrogging France and the UK, according to data from the IMF's October World Economic Outlook.

India's economy now has a nominal GDP of \$2.94 trillion. The report said, "India's economy is the fifth largest in the world with a GDP of \$2.94 trillion, overtaking the UK and France in 2019 to take the fifth spot".

The UK economy amounts to \$2.83 trillion and France with \$2.71 trillion.
