Main national event for International Day of Yoga to be held at Leh

The main national event for the International Day of Yoga will be held at Leh, the capital of Ladakh this year. The event, which is held on the 21st of June every year, will be led by Prime Minister Narendra Modi.

• The Prime Minister is expected to carry out yogasanas based on Common Yoga Protocol along with an anticipated gathering of 15 to 20 thousand people on the Yoga Day at Leh.

Union Govt.approved for the construction of Delhi-Baghpat highway

The National Highways Authority of India (NHAI) has got approval to construct the first phase of a new highway that will connect east Delhi's Akshardham to Uttarakhand's Dehradun, a distance of almost 170km.

- The first phase will connect Akshardham with west Uttar Pradesh's Baghpat, a distance of 32km, by a six-lane highway.
- The Second phase that will connect Baghpat to Dehradun, a distance of almost 140 km.
- The proposed new highway is expected to reduce travel time between Delhi and Uttarakhand's Dehradun by at least two-and-a-half hours.

Joy Bangla to be the National Slogan of Bangladesh

The Two-Judge bench of High Court of Bangladesh has ordered that 'Joy Bangla' will be the national slogan of Bangladesh.

- The court also directed the authorities to ensure that teachers and students use the slogan after assembly.
- Joy Bangla was the main slogan during the liberation war of Bangladesh fought against Pakistan in 1971

PhonePe earlier partnered with Yes Bank, but after YES Bank has been placed under moratorium by Reserve Bank of India due to which UPI transactions at PhonePe got disrupted.
