# Japan approves country's first abortion pill

- A Japanese health ministry panel has approved the country's first abortion pill developed by Britain's Linepharma International Ltd the Mefeco pill pack.
- It is an alternative to a surgical procedure in women's reproductive rights in Japan. The pill is awaiting final approval from the health minister, according to The Japan Times.

## India has moved up 6 places in the World Bank's Logistics Performance Index

- India, which was ranked 44th out of 139 countries in 2018 in the World Bank's Logistics Performance Index, is now ranked 38th, as soft and hard infrastructure and technology investments on both coasts have helped restore its port performance to domestic economic poles.
- India ranked 22nd in international exports in 2023 and moved up four places to 48th in logistics efficiency and equity.
