New study discovers 62 desiccation-tolerant vascular plant species

- India's biodiversity hotspot, the Western Ghats, has 62 desiccation-tolerant vascular plant species that can be used in agriculture, especially in water-scarce areas, a new study has found.
- Out of the list of 62 species, 16 are Indian species and 12 are endemic to the Western Ghats, highlighting the importance of WG as a global DT hotspot. According to the study, apart from rocks, tree trunks in partially shaded forests were also found to be important habitats for DD species.

Green panacea for reclamation of effluents discharged during crude oil excavation and processing

- A material has been discovered to help recover wastewater discharged during crude oil excavation and processing. This green panacea is formulated with a mixture of plant-based biomass, biosurfactant and NPK fertilizer.
- This "wonder mixture" helps prevent environmental pollution from water generation and is used to maintain the green revolution. It also helps increase crop production to meet the ever-growing food demand.
