

National News

India and UAE have entered into two MoUs to enhance transactions.

- India and the United Arab Emirates on July 15 signed two MoUs for trade cooperation, to further develop their payment and messaging systems and use their local currencies for crossborder transactions.
- The agreement envisages the use of local currencies for cross-border transactions, including all current account transactions and permitted capital account transactions between the two countries.

The Union Home Minister inaugurated the National Grand Conference on FPO in the Cooperative Sector.

- Union Home Minister Amit Shah inaugurated the Grand National Conference on "Farmers Producer Organization and FPO in Cooperative Sector" in New Delhi on July 14.
- In our largest country where about 65 crore people are involved in agriculture, this conference is organized with the objective of reviving the cooperative movement, modernizing technology and reaching new heights with transparency. It is significant that at this conference he launched a major initiative to create 1,100 new FPOs.

Central government has approved Rs 180 crore for flood affected Himachal Pradesh.

- The central government has approved a resolution to release Rs 180 crore to the state under the State Disaster Relief Fund (SDRF) to provide relief to the people who have suffered due to severe floods in Himachal Pradesh.
- It is notable that the approval of this relief fund has been given by Union Home Minister Amit Shah. Two more MI-17V5 helicopters have been deployed to evacuate flood-affected people.

India and France have entered into an MoU to manufacture warships in India.

- Defense Public Sector Undertakings (DPSUs) of India and France have signed MoUs for the joint production of submarines and warships and their components in Kolkata and Mumbai respectively for export to the rest of the world.
- These MoUs are said to further strengthen Prime Minister Modi's "Make in India" initiative. It has also been announced that Mumbai-based Mazagon Dock Shipbuilders will work with the French Naval Group to manufacture "Scorpeneclass submarines".

"Bhoomi Samman 2023" will be launched by the President of India in New Delhi.

- "Bhoomi Samman 2023" will be launched by the President of India Draupadi Murmu in New Delhi on July 18, comprising Nine State Secretaries and 68 District Collectors who have excelled in completing key components of the project to modernize digital India land records.
- The President said that this "Bhoomi Samman" project is a good example of central-state cooperative federalism based on trust and partnership and this project has been undertaken with the aim of improving the quality of life of the people through this project.

An MoU has been signed between Tezpur University and IITM Pune for research on carbon.

- A Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) was signed between the University of Tezpur and the Indian Institute of Tropical Meteorology (IITM), Pune, to assess and re-examine the net ecosystem transfer of carbon dioxide in Assam's famous Kaziranga National Park.
- The Memorandum of Understanding has been entered into between Tezpur University and IITM to collaborate and develop various research areas related to "Greenhouse Gases"





and Biosphere - Atmosphere Exchange of Energy".

The central government has formed a new committee to review all NSO data.

- Reorganizing the Standing Committee on Economic Statistics (SCES) set up in late 2019, the central government has set up a study group in July 2023 to review and revise official data from employment and consumption expenditure surveys.
- In a recently issued order, the **Ministry of Statistics** has mentioned that the SCES, which was tasked with analyzing only the economic indicators of the surveys conducted under the National Statistical Office (NSO), will now be replaced by the **Standing Committee on Statistics (SCoS).**

Tamil Nadu tops Export Preparedness Index 2022 - Niti Aayog latest report

- According to Niti Aayog's Export
 Preparedness Index 2022 published in July
 2023, Tamil Nadu has topped the "Coastal
 States Category", overtaking Maharashtra and
 Gujarat.
- The index is developed based on operational efficiency and export capacity of states to assess their preparedness and it is notable that the report of the Niti Aayog was released by its Chief Executive Officer B. V. R. Subrahmanyam. Following Tamil Nadu(80.89) in this ranking are Maharashtra(78.20), Karnataka(76.36), Gujarat, Andhra Pradesh and Odisha.

The Union Home Minister launched the "CRCS-Sahara Refund" website of Sahara Group.

 Union Home Minister Amit Shah launched the "CRCS-Sahara Refund Portal" on July 18 in New Delhi. This portal has been developed with the aim of getting more than 10 crore shareholders of Sahara Group their money back.

• The Union Home Minister said that in the first phase, 4 crore shareholders are eligible to receive up to Rs 10,000 and once this initiative is successful, further decisions will be taken to address the demands of the shareholders who are stuck with a lot of money in the cooperative societies of the group.

The IEA has published its medium-term market supply report "Oil 2023".

- The International Energy Agency (IEA) in collaboration with the Petroleum Planning and Analysis Organization (PPAC) has released a medium-term market sales report titled "Oil 2023" under the MoP and NG.
- "India's energy demand is growing much faster than other major economies" and the same trend is expected to continue. IEA Institute Secretary Shri Pankaj Jain said that growth in all sectors will be driven by favorable demographics supported by industrialization and urbanization.

The Indian Army and Ashok Leyland have signed contracts worth Rs.800 crore.

- The Indian Army has on July 17 entered into several contracts with commercial vehicle manufacturer Ashok Leyland for procurement of Field Artillery Tractor (FAT 4×4) and Gun Towing Vehicle (GTV 6×6).
- The deal, worth **Rs 800 crore**, sees the FAT 4×4 and GTV 6×6 as the mainstays. These are "**Special Vehicles**" used to tow light and medium guns, the agency said.

The Prime Minister of India inaugurated the new terminal complex of Port Blair Airport.

• Prime Minister Modi inaugurated the **new** integrated terminal complex of Veer





- **Savarkar International Airport** in Port Blair, the capital of Andaman and Nicobar on July 18.
- Prime Minister Modi said at the inauguration that the new complex is designed to "Enhance ease of travel, improve ease of doing business and improve connectivity".

PNB Bank has launched a scheme "PNB PALAASH" for environmental sustainability management.

- Punjab National Bank (PNB) on July 17 launched a flagship initiative "PNB Palash" as its environmental initiative for sustainable management of environment.
- The process is expected to take about **Eight** months. The campaign will lead to cost, savings and operational efficiencies for environmental protection through measures such as energy and waste management, resource conservation, paper reduction, streamlined digital processes, PNB said in its statement.

The US-India Strategic Clean Energy Partnership Ministerial Conference begins in New Delhi.

- A ministerial conference on the US-India Strategic Clean Energy Partnership (SCEP) began in New Delhi on July 18 between Natural Gas and Petroleum Minister Hardeep Singh Puri and US Energy Secretary Jennifer Granholm.
- While ensuring healthy growth rates between the two countries, the summit aims to represent a comprehensive vision for zero carbon in the Strategic Clean Energy Partnership.

The Indian Army has started an All Women Tri-Army Motorcycle Rally from New Delhi to Dras.

 To commemorate 24 years of victory over Pakistan in 1999 Kargil war in Ladakh and to express their indomitable spirit by prioritizing women, the Indian Army has launched the triarmy "Nari Sashaktikaran Women

- Motorcycle Rally" at the "National War Memorial" in New Delhi.
- It is significant that the **Indian Army Chief General Manoj Pandey** flagged off this grand rally on July 18, 2023.

India-led ASEAN Conference on Traditional Medicines has begun in New Delhi.

- The ASEAN Conference on Traditional Medicines begins in New Delhi on July 20 under the leadership of India.
- The conference aims to share best practices between India and ASEAN member countries and to develop a roadmap for their future cooperation in the field of traditional medicine.

President of India Murmu is scheduled to inaugurate the two-day Library Festival 2023 in New Delhi.

- The Union Government has announced that the President of India Draupadi Murmu will inaugurate the two-day Library Festival 2023 at Pragati Maidan in New Delhi on August 5.
- The event system for libraries across India and promote excellence and innovation in the library sector.

The Ministry of Culture plans to revive "The country's ancient stitched shipbuilding Tankai method".

- The Union Ministry of Culture has entered into a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with the Indian Navy to revive and preserve the 2000year-old ancient technology of shipbuilding known as stitching(Tankai method).
- The agreement was executed on July 18, 2023. It is also said that India has a strong maritime heritage and its strong use has played an important role in trade, exploration and cultural exchange and the country's heritage and economy will progress by restoring India.





Universal Postal Union (UPU) Regional Office opened in New Delhi on July 19.

- The Universal Postal Union (UPU) Regional
 Office was inaugurated in New Delhi on 19th
 July 2023 by the Chief Executive Officer of the
 Universal Postal Union (DG UPU) Mr.
 Masahiko Metoki and Union Minister of
 Communications Shri Devusinh Chauhan.
- It is significant that this specialized center has been opened with the objective of speeding up the technical assistance activities of the UPU in the South Asian region.

The 3rd meeting of the Indo-Russian Commission on Military Cooperation has been held in New Delhi.

- The 3rd General Meeting of the "Working Group on Military Co-Operation" for the year 2023 of the Intergovernmental Commission on Military and Related Technical Cooperation of India and Russia has been held.
- It is notable that the conference was held from July 18 to 19 at the Maneksha Center in New Delhi. The conference was held with the aim of expanding the security engagements between the two sides and further strengthening new initiatives under the bilateral security cooperation mechanism.

The Union Minister will inaugurate the two-day "National Conference of Rural WASH Partners".

- Union Minister Gajendra Singh Shekhawat is scheduled to inaugurate the two-day National Conference of "Rural WASH Partners" forum on July 21 at Vigyan Bhawan, New Delhi.
- Under the theme "Accelerating and Enhancing Progress towards Swachh Sujal Bharat", the conference aims to enable its participants to share their experiences and identify and develop new avenues of collaboration across the WASH sector.

A Memorandum of Understanding has been signed between India and Japan to develop a semiconductor distribution system.

- The Government of India signed an MoU on July 20 with the Government of Japan to develop a semiconductor supply chain.
- Information Technology Minister Ashwini
 Vaishnav said at the MoU in New Delhi that the
 MoU aims to enhance bilateral cooperation in
 equipment research, manufacturing,
 semiconductor design, capacity building and
 their delivery services.

The National Geoscience Awards - 2022 will be presented by the President of India in New Delhi.

- Draupadi Murmu (President of India) is scheduled to present the prestigious National Geoscience Awards for the year 2022 at the cultural center of Rashtrapati Bhavan in New Delhi on July 24.
- It is notable that the "Union Ministry of Mines" presents these National Geoscience Awards in three categories every year. Established in 1966, the award is a prestigious award given to individuals and organizations who have demonstrated outstanding innovation and commitment to the field of geosciences.

The Central Government has introduced the Cinematograph (Amendment) Bill, 2023 in the Rajya Sabha.

- Union Information and Broadcasting
 Minister Anurag Singh Thakur introduced the
 Cinematograph (Amendment) Bill in the Rajya
 Sabha on July 20.
- This bill is designed to prevent the problems of piracy in the film industry and to strengthen the film industry by providing some important measures to the film artists and the Union Minister said that this Bill will be an opportunity to further amend the Cinematograph Act of 1952.





India's HAL and Argentina's Ministry of Defense have signed a contract for helicopters.

- Hindustan Aeronautics Limited(HAL) signed a cooperation agreement with Argentina's Ministry of Defense on July 20, to manufacture and procure light and medium utility helicopters for Argentina's Central Armed Forces.
- The deal marks the Second South American country to have expressed interest in purchasing helicopters manufactured by HAL. It is notable that Ecuador Country has previously purchased seven Advanced Light Helicopters (Dhruv) from HAL.

PFC has entered into MoUs with 20 companies worth over ₹2.37 trillion.

- Power Finance Corp Ltd(PFC), a central energy transition company, has signed various MoUs worth ₹2.37 trillion with nearly 20 private and public sector companies, the company said in a statement on July 21.
- These MoUs are intended to further enhance **PFC's power transmission division** and provide **guidelines** that can further strengthen the objectives of the country's energy transition goals.

India and Sri Lanka have entered into five MoUs for the development of major economic cooperation.

- Prime Minister Modi of India and Sri Lankan President Ranil Wickremesinghe signed five agreements covering major areas of economic cooperation on July 21 during the recent visit of the Sri Lankan President to India.
- Various MoUs have been signed in Sri Lanka's
 Trincomalee district for economic development projects and renewable energy development in the country. The President of Sri Lanka said that these agreements will be a milestone in strengthening the good relations between the two countries.

The 14th Clean Energy Ministerial (CEM) and 8th Mission Innovation (MI) meeting begins under the chairmanship of the Union Minister.

 The 14th Clean Energy Ministerial and 8th Mission Innovation Public Meeting began on 21st July 2023 in Goa under the chairmanship

- of Union Minister for Renewable Energy and Power **Shri RK Singh.**
- The conference is organized with the aim of discussing the possible ways to overcome the burdens and obstacles in the way of energy transmission of the country and how to overcome the problems in them. Also in this conference, the Union Minister stated that by 2030, 50% of the country's energy needs will be met from Non-fossil sources and natural factors.

DGR has signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with IBM for the development of exservicemen.

- The Directorate General of Resettlement (DGR) has entered into a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with IBM to improve the quality of life of ex-servicemen by providing them with a second job and facilitating their seamless integration into the civilian workforce.
- It is reported that the quality of life of exservicemen who have served and retired from the army will improve through this recently concluded agreement.

SJVN has signed an agreement with REC to get Rs 50,000 crore in funding.

- According to an SJVN company report released on July 21, an agreement has been entered into with REC to provide financial assistance to the project for setting up new power plants based on renewable energy sources.
- Through this agreement, REC has agreed to finance major development projects of SJVN and its subsidiaries to the tune of Rs 50,000 crore.
 - It is notable that the deal is aimed at acquiring nearly 25 GW of generating capacity by the end of the current decade.

The Union government has launched technology advancement schemes in crop insurance to empower farmers.

To empower farmers and further strengthen operations, the Ministry of Agriculture Welfare has on July 21 launched several new





- **High-technological advancement** schemes under the **Pradhan Mantri Fazal Bima Yojana** (PMFBY).
- Union Minister Tomar said that these projects have been developed with the aim of reaching full benefit to the small farmer in every village by using technology through these initiative projects.

International news

India plans to set up an office in Paris for DRDO to develop light fighter jet engines.

- India's DRDO plans to set up a regional office in the French capital of Paris to jointly develop a light combat aircraft between India and France after the meeting between Indian Prime Minister Modi and French President Emmanuel Macron on July 14.
- The Prime Minister of India said that a blueprint for this initiative will be prepared between Safran, a French defense company, and India's DRDO.

A state of emergency has been declared to curb food inflation in Nigeria.

- President Bola Tinubu declared a state of emergency on July 14, 2023 to control inflation in Nigeria.
- President Tinubu has passed a resolution in the country's parliament with the main objectives of improving agriculture, reducing the cost of food and creating jobs. Nearly 25 million Nigerians are at high risk of food insecurity this year (by 2023), according to a January report by the United Nations.

IIT-Delhi plans to set up its new campus in UAE.

• The two countries signed an MoU on July 15 in the presence of Prime Minister Modi for the Delhi branch of the Indian Institute of Technology to set up its "First Global Regional Campus" in Abu Dhabi, UAE.

The Prime Minister of India has mentioned that through this agreement, India's technological capabilities will be taken to a global perspective. It also said that Post Graduate (PG) courses will start from January next year and Undergraduate (UG) courses from September 2024.

India and the UAE have signed an MoU to link India's "integrated payment interface" with the UAE's instant payment platform.

- India and UAE have signed some MoUs for cross-border transactions in local currencies (Indian rupee and UAE Dirham) and interconnection of their payment systems.
- The agreement will not only give a big boost to trade between the two countries but will pave the way for enhanced economic cooperation and will facilitate international financial relations, said RBI Governor Das.

The joint military exercise 'Nomadic Elephant 2023' between the Indian and Mongolian army has begun.

- The 15th edition of India-Mongolia joint military exercise "Nomadic Elephant 2023" began on July 17 in Ulaanbaatar, Mongolia. The joint military exercise is scheduled to take place from July 17 to 31.
- Joint military exercise "Nomadic Elephant" is an annual joint exercise between India and Mongolia. It is notable that the last edition was held in October 2019 at the Special Forces Training School, Bakloh.

Singapore's passport has emerged as the world's most powerful passport.

- Japan, which has held this position for many years, has been relegated to third place this year and Singapore's passport has emerged as the most powerful passport.
- This means that all citizens of Singapore can travel visa-free to 193 out of 227 destinations





around the world. It is notable that **Henley & Partners**, a global citizenship and residence consultancy based in London, produces this index annually.

India introduces the UPI system in Sri Lanka.

- The National Payments Regulatory Authority
 of India has on July 21 entered into an
 agreement with Sri Lanka's Lanka Pay to
 introduce the Unified Payments Interface (UPI)
 system in Sri Lanka.
- It is also reported that this agreement has been made with the aim of increasing Fintech connectivity and further development of trade between the two countries.

The European Union (EU) has announced 7.6 million euros in humanitarian aid to Afghanistan.

- The European Union has approved a resolution to provide 7.6 million euros in humanitarian aid to Afghanistan.
- The European Union has announced that this grant has been announced to help the people of the country who are stuck in dangerous situations such as economic crisis, food insecurity and lack of political stability to overcome the situation and restore irrigation facilities and non-agricultural land in six provinces across the country.

State news

New Center for AYUSH Health Services and Research opened in Goa.

- The Union Ministry of AYUSH has launched a new center for health and AYUSH research services at Ribandar in Goa in July 2023.
- The Ministry of AYUSH said that the Center has been launched with the aim of providing highquality health services at affordable cost to the public in the state and promoting research in traditional medicine. A library, a museum and a

laboratory to study marine medicines have also been started.

Largest "Kalaingar nootraandu Noolakam" opened in Madurai.

- On behalf of the Government of Tamil Nadu, a grand "Kalaingar nootraandu Noolakam ' has been opened for the benefit of the students with modern facilities and an area of 2,22,815 square feet on 2.61 acres of land owned by the Public Works Department on Pudunantham Road in Madurai.
- It is notable that Tamil Nadu Chief Minister M.
 K. Stalin inaugurated this library on July 15 at 5 pm.

The Chief Minister inaugurated the PM MITRA Campus in Amravati, Maharashtra.

- Maharashtra Chief Minister Eknath Shinde on July 16 inaugurated a mega integrated textile estates and apparel park named "PM Mitra Park" in Amravati, Maharashtra in the presence of Union Textiles Minister Piyush Goyal and others.
- Also in this opening ceremony, some MoUs about PM-MITRA Park and some MoUs with some investors have been signed between the Central Government and the Maharashtra Government. It is notable that in March this year, the central government announced the locations of setting up Mitra Parks across the country for the development of the textile industry.

Tripura state has started free ferry service for "school students".

The Department of School Education, Tripura has launched a "Free School Boat" service in July 2023 to transport poor students living in Dumbur Lake Islands in Gumati District, Tripura to their schools.





• The chief minister said the move was taken in view of the fact that poor children living in Dumbur Lake and the many small islands around it often find it difficult to go to school as they cannot afford the "boat fare". It is noteworthy that Dumbur Lake, surrounded by 48 islands, is 120 km from the state capital.

The 3rd G20 Finance Ministers and Central Bank Governors Summit is taking place in Gandhinagar.

- The third G20 "Finance Ministers and Central Bank Governors (FMCBGs)" Summit began on July 17 in Gandhinagar, Gujarat.
- Reserve Bank Governor Dr Shaktikanta Das and Union Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman are jointly presiding over the conference. The conference aims to address global challenges such as food and energy insecurity and climate change and ensure enhanced economic cooperation.

The Defense Minister has laid foundation stones for several development projects in Lucknow.

- Union Defense Minister Rajnath Singh on July 17 in Lucknow, Uttar Pradesh laid the foundation stone for several development projects, including the "Madiaon-IIM Crossing flyover", part of the National Highways Project and two national highway projects worth Rs 3300 crore.
- It is significant that through these projects, the economic development of the people will be further strengthened and he also inaugurated the newly constructed "Alamnagar Railway Station" on this occasion to enable the passengers of the "western part" of the city including Alamnagar and Rajajipuram to board and alight the trains without crowding to the capital of New Delhi.

Himachal Chief Minister has launched a website (PORTAL) to help the natives affected by the calamity in the state.

- Himachal Pradesh Chief Minister Sukhvinder Sukhu launched a website "Aapda Rahat Kosh 2023" (PORTAL) on July 16 with an aim to help the disaster affected people of Himachal Pradesh state.
- The Chief Minister of Himachal Pradesh said that the magnitude of the calamity is very large and the state has never seen such a huge impact.

Uttarakhand's Harela festival has begun.

- The Shravan Harela festival is celebrated to mark the beginning of the rainy season (monsoon) which is celebrated in the month of Shravan in the Hindu calendar. Harela means "Green day".
- Also during this festival farmers start the traditional sowing cycle in their fields. It is celebrated on 16th and 17th July every year.

Union Minister in augurates "Global Maritime India Summit 2023" in Mumbai.

- Ports and Shipping Minister Sarbananda
 Sonowal is set to inaugurate the third edition of the prestigious "Global India Maritime
 Summit" in 2023, the Union government said.
- The conference is scheduled to be held from October 17 to 19. The conference is aimed at creating new investment opportunities, promoting ease-of-doing business and enhancing trade between countries through cooperation in knowledge and technology.

An all women meter testing lab has been inaugurated in Odisha.

 To empower Odisha's local women in STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics) field, Tata Power Southern Odisha Distributing Company (TPSODL) has set up a state-of-the-art all-women meter test in the state.





• The company said that the meter testing operations at this laboratory in Odisha's Berhampur will be manned by women and will test 35,000-45,000 meters annually. It is also significant that TPSODL is a joint venture between Tata Power and Odisha State Government.

Chachin Grazing festival is celebrated with great enthusiasm by local pastoralists in Arunachal state.

- Chachin grazing festival is celebrated with great enthusiasm by the local herdsmen in Tawang, a region near the Pumla Pass in Arunachal Pradesh.
- The **two-day festival** was enthusiastically attended by pastoralists from all over Tawang and surrounding areas. This festival is very well celebrated by bringing the culture of the state to the people all over the country.

Employment Working Group-EWG meeting begins in Indore.

- Under India's G-20 leadership, the fourth and final Employment Working Group-EWG meeting of this segment began on July 19 in Indore in the state of Madhya Pradesh. The summit is slated to conclude with a meeting of all G-20 labor and employment ministers from July 19 to July 21.
- The meeting is aimed at finalizing and updating the Ministerial Declaration and outcome documents. Bhupender Yadav (Union Minister of Labor and Employment) is presiding over this public meeting.

Union Health Minister launches Global Food Regulatory Summit 2023

 Union Health Minister Dr Mansukh Mandaviya inaugurated the Global Food Regulation Summit 2023 in New Delhi on July 20. • The conference is scheduled to be a **two-day summit**. The conference aims to create a global platform for regulators to improve regulatory frameworks through collaboration.

Gujarat to launch country's first 'satellite network website'

- OneWeb and the Gujarat state government have entered into an MoU to establish a "satellite network Portal" near Mehsana in its capital Gandhinagar on July 19.
- Gujarat becomes India's first state to get
 "satellite network Potal" through this project.
 This project is developed under Digital India
 with an aim to provide secure and high-speed
 Internet access to local bodies, villages, district
 panchayats and government departments across
 the country.

The G20's "Science 20" summit has begun at the prestigious Isha Yoga Center in Coimbatore.

- The Science 20 Summit under the leadership of G-20 by India began on July 20 at the prestigious Isha Yoga Center in Coimbatore.
- A 2-day conference will be held from 20th and 21st July. The conference aims to discuss topics such as green energy, holistic health and how to connect science with the general public.

Odisha State Cabinet approves Khadag River Basin Project.

- Odisha Chief Minister Naveen Patnaik on July 20 approved the Khadag River Basin Project, which will benefit the economy and quality of life of 20,000 people.
- The scheme is designed to benefit all the general public in the surrounding areas of three districts namely Kandhamal - Baliguda block, Boudh district block and Gudvela block of Balangir district.
 - It is notable that **Rs.126 crore** has been allocated for this project.





The Poonch district administration is going to start a two-day "Passport Mela".

- The Poonch district administration of Jammu and Kashmir, in collaboration with the "Union Ministry of External Affairs", has launched a Passport Mela on July 22.
