National News

A Memorandum of Understanding has been entered into between the Bureau of Water Efficiency and the Indian Plumbing Association to strengthen water management.

- The **Bureau of Water Utilization Efficiency** (BWUE) has signed an MoU with the **Indian Plumbing Association (IPA)** on **July 7** to further strengthen water positivity and water management.
- The MoU is designed to focus on awareness and development of rainwater harvesting structures, gray and black water treatment, low-flow devices and sanitary products and water audit of the built environment.

The Defense Minister has launched "Single Window NCC Integrated Software" for Army Cadets.

- Union Defense Minister Rajnath Singh launched "NCC Integrated Software" for Army Cadets on July 07 to promote digitization and enhance its growth through Digital India programme.
- It is notable that this NCC integrated software is developed by **Bhaskaracharya Institute for Space Applications and Geoinformatics (BISAG).**

The Urban 20 (U20) Mayoral Summit has been launched in Gandhinagar.

- The Urban 20 Mayors Summit was inaugurated on July 7 by Gujarat Chief Minister Shri Bhupendra Patel and Minister of State for Housing and Urban Affairs Shri Kaushal Kishore in the state capital GandhiNagar.
- The conference aims to address the growing challenges of **urbanization** and **climate** resilience and to build sustainable climate cities.

An MoU has been signed between L&T and Navantia for the Navy's P75 submarine development project.

• India's renowned Larsen & Toubro (L&T) and Spain's renowned Navantia have signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) for the development and technical assistance program for the Indian Navy's P75 (India) class submarines. • It is significant that this is **India's largest** defense acquisition project and as per the contract, Navantia will design P75(I) submarines based on its **S80 class submarines** and supply them to the Indian Navy and the project is expected to be valued at over **4.8 billion Euros**.

National Law University of Delhi has launched a program called Eklavya.

- The National Law University (NLU) in India's capital New Delhi has recently launched a pioneering research and education initiative called 'Eklavya'.
- The initiative aims to further strengthen Delhi's commitment to collaboration and to gain diverse perspectives through the expertise and skills of individuals without traditional law degrees.

Bilateral trade between India and Bangladesh starts in "rupees".

- It has been announced that the bilateral trade between India and Bangladesh will be denominated in Rupees at an international trade event organized by the Bangladesh Bank and the Indian High Commission on July 11 in Dhaka, the capital of Bangladesh.
- Bangladesh is India's biggest trading partner in South Asia and with this decision, the bilateral relationship is expected to reach a new peak, said the Governor General of the Central Bank of Bangladesh, Abdur Rouf Talukder.

International Financial Services Centers Authority (IFSCA) has signed an MoU with IIML -EIC.

- The International Financial Services Centers Authority (IFSCA) signed the MoU on July 11 at the IIM Institutional Insurance Center (EIC) at the Noida campus in Uttar Pradesh.
- This MoU aims to create a framework for cooperation and understanding to support and strengthen **FinTech** and **TechFin** companies.

India and Maldives have signed MoUs for various development projects.

• A number of agreements and MoUs were signed during a delegation-level meeting between Union External Affairs Minister **S Jaishankar** and Maldives Prime Minister **Abdulla Shahid** at the Hyderabad House in **New Delhi** on **July 11**.

• It is notable that MoUs have been signed between the two countries for various cooperation projects such as development of sports grounds, setting up of a mental ward hospital, school digitization project, preservation of hospitals and culture and improvement of schools.

The Union Minister launched the 'Green BHEL' initiative for sustainable growth and development.

- The 'Green BHEL' initiative was launched by the Hon'ble Union Minister of Heavy Industries, Dr. Mahendra Nath Pandey at the Corporate Office of Bharat Heavy Electricals (BHEL) in New Delhi.
- Further strengthening the company's commitment to environmental sustainability and enhancing its commitment to shift towards cutting-edge technologies and this initiative is also aimed at reducing its **Carbon Usages**.

The Center has approved a draft to provide Rs 7,532 crore to states for disaster relief.

- The Department of Expenditure of the Finance Ministry on July 12 announced Rs. 7,532 crore for their respective State Disaster Relief Funds (SDRF) after approving the draft list of relief that can be provided to 22 state governments.
- It is to be noted that this list has been released on the recommendation of the Union Ministry of Home Affairs. A separate State Disaster Response Fund (SDRF) is set up in each state under Section 48 (1) (a) of the Disaster Management Act, 2005.

An MoU has been entered into between MoD & FSSAI to ensure safe and nutritious food among the armed forces.

- A Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) has been signed between the Ministry of Defense (MoD) and the Food Safety and Standards Authority of India(FSSAI) in a significant step to ensure availability of safe and nutritious food and promote healthy eating habits among the country's armed forces.
- A book titled 'Healthy Recipes for Defence' was also released on the occasion. Developed by

FSSAI, this book covers **millet-based** and highly **nutritious foods**.

A unique global navigation satellite system called 'SAGAR SAMPARK' has been inaugurated to strengthen the maritime sector.

- The Ministry of Ports & Shipping has inaugurated 'SAGAR SAMPARK', a Domestic-Differential Global Navigation Satellite System (DGNSS) to innovate, build better infrastructure and strengthen the Indian Maritime Sector (Navy).
- The structure was inaugurated by Shri Sarbananda Sonowal on 12th July. It is designed to provide accurate positioning information and correct errors and faults in the Global Navigation Satellite System (GNSS).

A new campaign called BHARAT has been launched for the development of banks in the country.

- Shri Manoj Ahuja, Secretary, Ministry of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare, on July 12 launched a new initiative campaign for banks under the Agricultural Finance Framework BHARAT (Banks Heralding Accelerated Rural & Agriculture Transformation).
- This is a month-long country promotion campaign (July 15, 2023 to August 15, 2023). Shri Manoj Ahuja said that this initiative has been taken with the objective of making the banks in rural areas carry out agriculture and agriculture related activities with their own discretion.

India is planning to host the "ASEAN Conference on Traditional Medicine" in 2023.

- The Union AYUSH Ministry with the support of the ASEAN Secretariat, Ministry of External Affairs and Embassy of India plans to organize a "Conference on Traditional Medicines for ASEAN Countries" on July 20, 2023, the ASEAN organization said.
- The conference aims to strengthen the platform between India and ASEAN countries, share their best practices and **create a roadmap for future cooperation** in the field of traditional medicine.

- International Financial Services Centers Commission (IFSCA) and PIEDS BITS Pilani have entered into an MoU to create a new framework to support FinTech and TechFin companies and facilitate their collaboration.
- The MoU was executed on July 13 at the **BITS Pilani PIEDS Fin Xcelerator Center** in Pilani Campus, **Rajasthan**. The agreement also forms part of the promotion of the IFSCA (FinTech Incentive) Scheme 2022, **BITS** Pilani Institute of Education and Research said.

The Union Home Minister will inaugurate a one-day conference on "Strengthening PACS through FPOs" in New Delhi.

- Union Home Minister Mr. Amit Shah will inaugurate a one-day conference on "Strengthening Primary Agriculture Credit Societies (PACS) through Farmer Producer Organizations (FPOs)" in New Delhi on July 14.
- It is significant that the Union Ministry of Cooperatives and National Cooperative Development Corporation (NCDC) have jointly organized this grand conference. The conference also aims to discuss how to promote agricultural credit societies in the country.

The Union Fisheries Minister inaugurated an exhibition on fish cooperatives and fisheries startups.

- On the occasion of National Fisherman's Day, Union Fisheries Minister Parshotham Rupala inaugurated a grand exhibition on fish cooperatives and fishing startups at Mahabalipuram near Chennai, Tamil Nadu.
- The Union Minister said that the two-day program will evaluate the initiatives of the Indian Agricultural Research Organization and discuss progress with fisheries departments of various states.

The CDS inaugurated the LRMR Hangar & Dispersal at the Naval Air Base, Port Blair.

• **CDS Anil Chauhan** on July 10 inaugurated the LRMR Hangar & Dispersal Hall at the Naval

Air Base **INS Utkrosh** in Port Blair, the capital of Andaman and Nicobar.

With this new system, the twin hangar is spread over **6,000 square** meters and can accommodate a mix of **P8I aircraft** along with Tornier and advanced light helicopters, the CDS said during the inauguration ceremony.

India and UAE have entered into two MoUs to enhance transactions.

- India and the United Arab Emirates on July 15 signed two MoUs for trade cooperation, to further develop their payment and messaging systems and use their local currencies for cross-border transactions.
- The agreement envisages the use of local currencies for cross-border transactions, including all current account transactions and permitted capital account transactions between the two countries.

The Union Home Minister inaugurated the National Grand Conference on FPO in the Cooperative Sector.

- Union Home Minister Amit Shah inaugurated the Grand National Conference on "Farmers Producer Organization and FPO in Cooperative Sector" in New Delhi on July 14.
- In our largest country where about 65 crore people are involved in agriculture, this conference is organized with the objective of reviving the cooperative movement, modernizing technology and reaching new heights with transparency. It is significant that at this conference he launched a major initiative to create 1,100 new FPOs.

Central government has approved Rs 180 crore for flood affected Himachal Pradesh.

- The central government has approved a resolution to release Rs 180 crore to the state under the State Disaster Relief Fund (SDRF) to provide relief to the people who have suffered due to severe floods in Himachal Pradesh.
- It is notable that the approval of this relief fund has been given by Union Home Minister Amit Shah. Two more MI-17V5 helicopters have been deployed to evacuate flood-affected people.





India and France have entered into an MoU to manufacture warships in India.

- Defense Public Sector Undertakings (DPSUs) of India and France have signed MoUs for the joint production of submarines and warships and their components in Kolkata and Mumbai respectively for export to the rest of the world.
- These MoUs are said to further strengthen Prime Minister Modi's "Make in India" initiative. It has also been announced that Mumbai-based Mazagon Dock Shipbuilders will work with the French Naval Group to manufacture "Scorpeneclass submarines".

Justice Mussarat Hilali has become the second woman judge in the Supreme Court of Pakistan.

- Justice Mussarat Hilali took oath of office on July 07 and was sworn in as a female judge in the Supreme Court of Pakistan, making her the second woman to be sworn in as a judge in the country's Supreme Court.
- This is the first time in history that the Supreme Court of Pakistan will have **two women judges** and she has previously served as the Chief Justice of the Peshawar High Court (PHC).

Union Minister unveils bust of Swami Vivekananda in Tanzania

- Union External Affairs Minister (EAM) Dr S Jaishankar on July 06 unveiled a bust of India's renaissance sculptor Swami Vivekananda at the India Cultural Center in Dar es Salaam, Tanzania.
- The statue must surely be a testimony to his timeless teachings and it truly transcends the boundaries of his faith in humanity, said the Union External Affairs Minister.

SpaceX plans to launch "Satellite Internet service" in Mongolia.

- The Mongolian government has signed an agreement with **Elon Musk's SpaceX** to grant **two licenses**, subject to certain conditions, to provide internet services using low-orbit satellites.
- This will enable millions of **internet users** in Mongolia to access high-speed connectivity via

"**Starlink**", a satellite communications internet service operated by SpaceX, the Mongolian government said in a statement.

Turkey accepts Sweden's concession agreement to join NATO.

- **Turkey** on **July 10** ended its months-long opposition to Sweden's membership in the North Atlantic Treaty Organization(NATO), allowing Sweden to join the organization without opposition.
- Finland became the latest country to join the alliance on 4 April 2023, after 30 countries were already members of the organization. If Sweden joins with this approval, the number of NATO member states will increase to 32 and this will be a huge setback for Russia, according to world security experts.

India's HAL office in Malaysia has been opened to facilitate defense industry cooperation.

- Defense Minister Shri Rajnath Singh inaugurated the regional office of Hindustan Aeronautics Company (HAL) in Kuala Lumpur, the capital city of Malaysia on 11th July 2023 to boost defense exports, one of the main pillars of sustainable development of Indian defense Department and to facilitate defense industrial cooperation between the two countries.
- It will serve as a **Special hub** for **HAL's engagement** with the wider South and South East Asian region and a key security hub for other Indian defense PSUs, the Union Defense Minister said.

China has achieved the status of being the country that successfully launched the world's first liquid methane rocket.

- China's private space agency Landspace successfully launched the world's first methaneliquid oxygen rocket, the Zhuque-2 carrier, on July 12.
- With this, China has achieved the status of being the country that has successfully launched the **world's first liquid methane rocket**. And it is





notable that this is **Landspace's second attempt** after a failed launch in December.

India plans to set up an office in Paris for DRDO to develop light fighter jet engines.

- India's DRDO plans to set up a regional office in the French capital of Paris to jointly develop a light combat aircraft between India and France after the meeting between Indian Prime Minister Modi and French President Emmanuel Macron on July 14.
- The Prime Minister of India said that a blueprint for this initiative will be prepared between Safran, a French defense company, and India's DRDO.

The European Parliament (EU) has adopted new rules to increase energy savings.

- As part of the European Green Deal, the European Parliament approved plans to increase energy savings in July 2023 in order to set new energy savings targets for 2030. Members of Parliament passed the bill by a vote of 471 to 147.
- According to this, the project has been carried out with the aim of ensuring that its member countries reduce energy consumption by at least **11.7 percent by 2030** and ensure that member countries save energy by an **average of 1.5 percent.**

Elon Musk, the richest man in the world, has launched his artificial intelligence company xAI.

- Elon Musk, the leading billionaire, launched a new artificial intelligence (AI) company and website called xAI on July 12 with cutting-edge technologies and a team of former engineers from Alphabet, Google, Microsoft and OpenAI.
- It has been reported that Elon Musk will be the **director** of the company and **Jared Birchall** will be the **executive secretary**. Global industry experts say it aims to leverage the capabilities of other AI companies and platforms and achieve commercial growth.

The 7th Deputy - NSA level meeting of Colombo Security Conference was held in Maldives.

- The 7th Deputy national consultative level meeting of the Colombo Security Conference (CSC) was held in **Maldives** on **12th July 2023**.
- The meeting was attended by top security officials from member countries India, Sri Lanka, Maldives and Mauritius. Deputy National Security Adviser "Vikram Misri" chaired the Indian delegation at the meeting.
 - The meeting discussed regional cooperation, countering cross-border extremism and new proposals for action in 2023-2024.

India has decided to set up a new embassy of India and a statue of Thiruvalluvar in Marseille, France.

- Prime Minister Modi announced on July 14 that the Center has decided to set up a New Embassy of India in Marseille, France.
- Also, Prime Minister Modi mentioned in the announcement that a **Statue of Thiruvalluvar** will be erected in this **New embassy.** At the same time, India and France have agreed to use a common **UPI payment mechanism.**

The US Senate passed a resolution recognizing **Arunachal Prades**h as an integral part of India.

- The US Parliament on July 13 passed a resolution recognizing Arunachal Pradesh as an internal and integral part of India.
- This resolution reaffirms the United States Senate's recognition of the "McMahon Lines" as the international boundary between China and the Indian state of Arunachal Pradesh. The decision comes in contrast to China's longstanding claim that a large part of Arunachal Pradesh is its territory.

IMF approves Pakistan's three billion dollar loan

- The International Monetary Fund (IMF) has approved a major US \$3 billion loan program to bail out Pakistan from its severe financial burden.
- According to the agreement, Pakistan will receive about **\$1.2 billion** now and the rest will be disbursed over the next nine months. Notably, last week Pakistan received loans from **Saudi**



Arabia and the **United Arab Emirates (UAE)** while the official annual inflation rate is now nearly **30 percent**.

Rikkie Valerie Kollé, has become the first transgender to win the title of Miss Netherlands.

- **Rikkie Valerie Kollé** has become the **first transgender** to win the Miss Netherlands title. It is also notable that this is the **first time** in the history of the national and world pageant that a person of the third gender has won the crown.
- According to the country's beauty pageant organization, she is preparing to represent the Netherlands at the 72nd edition of Miss Universe (Miss Universe 2023) to be held in **El Salvador** after 22-year-old Ona Moody.

The Minister of State has inaugurated the Indian Mango Festival 'Aamrus' in Russia.

- Indian Mango Festival 'Aamrus' was inaugurated by Uttar Pradesh Minister Dinesh Pratap Singh and Ambassador of India to Russia Pavan Kapoor on 8th July in Moscow, the capital of Russia.
- Ambassador of India to Russia Pavan Kapoor said that this initiative has been taken with the aim of sharing their entire culture with each other through this event.

A state of emergency has been declared to curb food inflation in Nigeria.

- President Bola Tinubu declared a state of emergency on July 14, 2023 to control inflation in Nigeria.
- President Tinubu has passed a resolution in the country's parliament with the main objectives of improving agriculture, reducing the cost of food and creating jobs. Nearly 25 million Nigerians are at high risk of food insecurity this year (by 2023), according to a January report by the United Nations.

IIT-Delhi plans to set up its new campus in UAE.

• The two countries signed an MoU on July 15 in the presence of Prime Minister Modi for the Delhi branch of the Indian Institute of Technology to set up its "First Global Regional Campus" in Abu Dhabi, UAE. • The Prime Minister of India has mentioned that through this agreement, India's technological capabilities will be taken to a global perspective. It also said that Post Graduate (PG) courses will start from January next year and Undergraduate (UG) courses from September 2024.

Prime Minister Modi has launched various development projects worth Rs 6000 crore in Telangana.

- On the morning of July 08, 2023, Prime Minister Narendra Modi laid the foundation stone for various infrastructure development projects worth **Rs 6000 crore** in **Warangal**, Telangana.
- He is also launching various development projects to help the people of the region, starting with a **railway manufacturing facility** with an investment of Rs 500 crore and **176 km long national highway projects** worth Rs 5,550 crore.

Prime Minister Modi has launched various development projects worth Rs 12,100 crore in Varanasi.

- Prime Minister Modi laid the foundation stones of 29 development projects worth a total of nearly Rs 12,110 crore in Varanasi, Uttar Pradesh on July 7.
- It is mentioned include that these • redevelopment of Manikarnika and Harishchandra Ghats, 3 double rail over bridges (ROB), construction and renovation of 15 PWD roads. Prime Minister Modi has said that this project has been carried out in a very useful way for the people through these projects.

The Uttar Pradesh Government has approved two 800 MW thermal power projects.

- The Uttar Pradesh state cabinet on July 11 approved a plan to build two thermal power projects of nearly 800 MW each in Sonbhadra district at a cost of ₹18,000 crore.
- The state government said this is part of its efforts to provide affordable and uninterrupted electricity to all the people in the state.

- A path-breaking **Mobile-Dost-App** has been launched in **sync** with the integrated vision of **Apka-Mobile-Hamara-Daftar** as a pioneering initiative for mobile-based delivery and sharing of citizen-centric services in Jammu, one of the Union Territories of India. and Kashmir.
- The app has been launched with the aim of empowering the people of Jammu & Kashmir by providing them with a **comprehensive platform to access citizen services (G2C)** directly from their mobile devices, the central government said.

A memorandum of understanding has been entered into between the governments of Haryana and Tanzania.

- Haryana's Foreign Cooperation Department (FCD) and Tanzania Government's Investment Center (TIC) signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) on July 11 to further strengthen bilateral economic cooperation.
- The agreement is aimed at **facilitating and strengthening investment opportunities between bilateral companies**, ensuring sustainable economic growth and development.

DGCA approves Tamil Nadu's first flight training facility

- The Directorate of Civil Aviation (DGCA) has on July 11 approved the establishment of a special flight training center in TamilNadu for the EKVI flight training institute operating at the Salem airport.
- This approval makes the Center the **36th DGCA** approved Flying Training Center in India and the First Flying Training Center (FTO) in Tamil Nadu.

The Prime Minister has launched various developmental projects worth Rs 24,300 crore in Bikaner.

- Science & Technology; Union Minister of State for PMO, Public Grievances and Pensions Dr. Jitendra Singh inaugurated the "Multimedia Exhibition of Central Bureau of Communications (CBC)" on July 10 in Srinagar, the capital of Jammu & Kashmir.
- The 5-day exhibition will be held till July 14, 2023 and is organized with the aim of highlighting to the general public the methods for nine years of Seva, Sushasan and Garib Kalyan (prevention of accumulation of wealth).

Medical scientists from Tamil Nadu and Japan have discovered a treatment method to control muscular dystrophy.

- **Muscular dystrophy** is a very rare genetic disorder that can affect children. As a result, the movement of the muscles becomes paralyzed and it becomes completely immobilized.
- In order to prevent this condition in which the protein 'Dystrophin' of children suffering from

this disease decreases, it has been revealed in a medical study that the food product **'Beta Glucose'** increases the level of Dystrophin protein in the blood by **32 percent** through some medicinal food products. Accordingly, research has shown that consumption of this **beta-glucose** produces some changes in immunity and increases muscle strength within **45-50 days**.

The Chief Minister laid the foundation stone for development projects worth Rs 871 crore in Kadapa.

- Various development projects worth ₹871.72 crore, including a ₹567.72 crore drinking water project from the Brahmam Sagar reservoir in Kadapa district of Andhra Pradesh, to Kadapa Central City, have been approved by Chief Minister Y.S. Jagan Mohan Reddy laid the foundation stone on July 10.
- The chief minister said that through this project, the people and farmers in the surrounding areas will get maximum benefit and the supply of drinking water to the municipal workers will be strengthened.

The Chief Minister of Gujarat laid the foundation stone for the IAAD campus in Gandhinagar.

Accordingly, the agreement states that all government employees in the state, irrespective of caste and religion, should serve 3-5 years during their service in Durgam areas.

- Union Minister for Road Transport and Highways **Mr. Nitin Gadkari** laid the foundation stone for 3 national highway projects worth a total of **Rs.2,900 crore** in **Tirupati**, one of the major cities of Andhra State.
- In particular, the 35 km long NH-71 (up to Naidupate Turpu Kanupur section) will be constructed with an investment of ₹ 1,399 crore and following this almost 2 projects will be very useful for the people, the Union Minister said. And its total length is mentioned as 87 kilometers.

Chhattisgarh State Cabinet has approved the Investment Incentive Scheme for Industrial Development.

- Union Civil Aviation Minister Jyotiraditya Scindia on July 14 inaugurated the country's first elevated taxiway at the Indira Gandhi International Airport in the Indian capital, New Delhi.
- The 2.1 km long "Eastern Cross Taxiways (ECT)" is said to further enhance time management at Indira Gandhi International Airport (IGIA), the country's largest airport, which handles more than 1,500 flights daily.

- The Telangana High Court has recently ruled that the Telangana Eunuchs Act 1329 is unconstitutional and violative of the Constitution of India and violates the fundamental human rights of the transgender community.
- Recently, the judges hearing the matter, Chief Justice **Ujjal Bhuyan** and Justice **C.V Bhaskar Reddy** observed that the law is intrusive into the private affairs of the third gender community and an attack on their dignity.

• The third G20 Cultural Working Group meeting has begun in the World Heritage Site of Karnataka State's **Hampi** in the presence of Union Parliamentary Affairs Minister **Prahlad** Joshi.





• The purpose of this conference is to discuss four themes proposed under the President of India and it is a **two-day conference**.

New Center for AYUSH Health Services and Research opened in Goa.

- The Union Ministry of AYUSH has launched a new center for health and AYUSH research services at Ribandar in Goa in July 2023.
- The Ministry of AYUSH said that the Center has been launched with the aim of providing highquality health services at affordable cost to the public in the state and promoting research in traditional medicine. A library, a museum and a laboratory to study marine medicines have also been started.

Science and Technology

Odisha TV has introduced India's first AI news anchor.

- Odisha Television Corporation (OTV) launched Lisa, the Country's first artificial intelligence (AI) based news anchor, in the state capital Bhubaneswar on July 09.
- It is reported that this AI Lisa, powered by AI and machine learning, will now deliver messages in **Odia and English**. It is also notable that two months ago, **Kuwait News Agency** also launched their own AI new anchor, '**Fedha**'.

Chandrayaan 3 successfully launched.

- Chandrayaan 3, the country's third lunar mission, was successfully launched from the second launch pad of the Sathish Dhawan Space Centre in Sriharikota on July 14 at 2.35 pm.
- LVM-3 rocket is used for this launch. The Chandrayaan 3 spacecraft is intended to achieve lunar orbit, perform a soft landing on the lunar surface using a lander, and thoroughly explore the lunar surface.

- A senior official has said that the Indian Space Agency has decided to opt for the auction route to **commercialize** this small-scale rocket and not only manufacture the SSLV, but completely privatize it.

Prime Minister Modi has been awarded France's highest award "Grand Cross of the Legion of Honour".

- Indian Prime Minister Narendra Modi was awarded the "Grand Cross of the Legion of Honor" by French President Emmanuel Macron on 13 July 2023. Notably, it is the highest French honor for a civilian or military command.

Taarini Suri won the Under-17 Girls' Singles title at the GMBA Championship.

- Taarini Suri won the Under-17 girls' singles and doubles titles at the Greater Mumbai Badminton Association (GMPA) Championship.
- It is notable that Taarini won the final match with Nishika Gokhe of Nagpur by 21-11, 21-23, 21-17 points.

Gold for India in recurve category at Junior World Championships.

• India's **Parth Salunkhe** has won **gold** in the recurve category at the 2023 World Junior Championships.

- He won first place by throwing a distance of **20.23 meters** in this competition. It is also notable that he has won the **gold medal** in the **2019** Asian Athletics Championship and the silver medal in the **2017** Championship.

Lyudmyla of Ukraine has won the mixed doubles title at Wimbledon.

- India's Lakshya Sen won the men's singles title of Canada Open Badminton 2023 at Calgary, Canada on July 09 night.
- He defeated China's Li Shi Feng by 21-18, 22-20 points to win the championship. And this is Commonwealth champion Lakshya Sen's first BWF World Tour title after nearly a year.

Archaeological discovery

183 rare items including gold jewelry and eyeliner sticks have been found at the bottom.

- On July 08, the Department of Archeology informed that in the **9th phase of excavation** at Keezhadi in **Sivagangai** district, gold ornaments, copper rod for applying eyelash, cosmetic stick etc. have recently been found.
- Also, **183 items** have been found so far, according to **Sivanandam Aiya**, Commissioner of Archaeology. It is notable that the 9th phase of excavation work at Keezhadi was started by Tamil Nadu Chief Minister Stalin on **6th April** last.

About 324 artifacts have been found in Thirukkolur excavations.

- Adichanallur in Tuticorin district and its surrounding areas have been excavated due to the presence of ancestors or old people and till now nearly 324 artifacts such as medieval coins, bronze ring, bronze bangle, glass beads, flint statues, flint beads, fragments of glass bangle, Chinese pottery have been found.
- It is also notable that Union Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman had announced that a world-class museum will be set up for the objects found in Adichanallur in the last Union Budget Session of 2020.

ONGC has become the first PSU in the country to receive the Anti-Bribery Management System certification.

- Oil and Natural Gas Corporation (ONGC) has become the country's first Central Public Sector Enterprise (CPSE) to receive Anti-Bribery Management System (ABMS) certification from InterCert USA, an international certification body.
- It is also notable that earlier in 2005, the company was the first organization to adopt the Integrity Pact (IP) through "Transparency International".

Agreement between AWS and Dr. Reddy's Laboratories for supply of affordable and innovative medicines.

- Amazon Web Services (AWS) on July 10 Dr. Reddy's Laboratories, it chose the company and a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) for business development was signed between the two companies.
- The deal is aimed at improving its digital platform and helping healthcare providers better monitor services to help deliver faster services to more than **1.5 billion** patients worldwide by **2030**.

Dell Technologies and Intel are planning to join forces to launch an AI-capable lab in India.

- Dell Technologies and renowned chipmaker Intel signed an agreement on July 10 to launch an artificial intelligence (AI) capable development lab in India.
- Through this joint collaboration, the agreement aims to make college and school students **industry ready** and bridge their digital skills gap.

Reduction of 18% levied on food items in theaters to 5%.

• Recently, the Goods and Services Tax (GST) body, headed by the Union Finance Minister and comprising representatives from all states and Union Territories, has decided to reduce the service tax levied on food and beverages in theaters from 18% to 5%.

• This tax evasion is said to further strengthen the growth of the cinema exhibition sector, where food and beverages in theaters have been a major revenue earner, earning up to 35% of revenue.

Razorpay has launched its "First International Payment Gateway System".

- Fintech giant Razorpay announced on July 12 that it will launch its "First international payment gateway" for the Malaysian market in partnership with payments company Curlec.

India to become world's second largest economy -Goldman Sachs Report

- By 2075, India's economy will overtake not only Japan and Germany but also the US to become the world's **second-largest economy, Goldman Sachs**, an American multinational investment bank and financial services firm, said in its report.
 - At present, **India is the fifth largest economy in the world** after Germany, Japan, China and USA in economic terms. And the report is based on factors such as India's continued progress in innovation and technology, high capital investment and increasing labor & productivity, the agency said.


