

National News

IMS Noida has launched a Zero-Waste campus.

- The Indian Pollution Control Association (IPCA) and Noida Institute of Management Studies (IMS) have jointly launched the Zero-Waste Campus in August 2023.
- It focuses on efficient recycling processes, source separation and complete disposal of waste and the complex is designed with the aim of achieving 100% recycling by installing an Aerobin machine to remove waste.

Memorial Day is observed as a national day to remember those who lost their lives during the partition of India.

- India observes August 14, 2023 as Partition
 Day to honor the fierce struggles and sacrifices
 that took place during the partition of India and
 Pakistan in 1947.
- Indian Prime Minister Modi has declared 14th August as Partition Memorial Day or "Vibhajan Vibhishika Smriti Diwas". Our Prime Minister said that this day reminds us of the need to eradicate the deadly poison of social divisions and disharmony and further strengthen the spirit of social harmony, unity and human empowerment.

A joint venture agreement has been signed between the Union Ministry of Tourism and MakeMyTrip to facilitate the travel of tourists.

- MakeMyTrip, an online travel services company, has entered into an MoU with the Union Ministry of Tourism on August 13 to promote various tourist destinations in the country and facilitate their travel.
- The agreement is aimed at enhancing the company's "Traveler's Map of India" microsite and making it easier for travelers to find places within the country.

• It is notable that this **microsite** is designed in line with the **DekhoApnaDesh** scheme of the **Central Government.**

An Indo-Jewish cultural heritage square (arena) has been opened in Israel.

- To honor and celebrate India's 77th Independence Day, an "Indo-Jewish Cultural Square" (Arena) in Eilat, Israel has been inaugurated by the government of the country on August 15.
- The organization is dedicated to the "Civilized Bond" of strong and good diplomatic relations between the two countries. It is designed to symbolize the friendship, love, mutual concern and deep state connection between India and Israel, according to the Mayor of Eilat, Eli Lankri.

CCEA has approved 7 major development projects of the Ministry of Railways worth Rs 32,500 crore.

- The Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs
 (CCEA) has on August 16, 2023 approved
 seven major development projects of the
 Ministry of Railways with funding of nearly Rs
 32,500 crore from the Central Government.
- These development projects are designed to facilitate the operations of the railway sector to the people and to reduce the **problems** and **congestion** in it and to provide the necessary infrastructural development in the sector. It is also reported that these projects cover nearly 35 **districts** and ensure their development.

The Union Cabinet has approved a Rs 13,000 crore scheme to support traditional artisans of the country.

The central government has approved the PM
 Vishwakarma Development Scheme in August
 2023 to support India's urban and rural traditional artisans and their talent at an
 estimated cost of Rs 13,000 crore.





• The project is designed to strengthen the family-based livelihood practice of artists and artisans and develop their **traditional skills of working** with their hands and tools. It is significant that this **is a 5 year project.**

The Union Cabinet has approved a Memorandum of Understanding between India and Australia to enhance cooperation in the field of sports.

- The Union Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports and Australia's Department of Health and Aged Care signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) on August 16 to further strengthen cooperation in the sports sector between the two countries.
- The program is designed to facilitate bilateral exchange programs in the field of sports between the two countries, expanding knowledge and expertise in athlete and coach training and development, sports science, sports governance and integrity and their grassroots participation.

The President of India has launched INS Vindhyagiri, a type of warship that does not get caught in the enemy's radars.

- Indian President Draupadi Murmu launched India's new warship 'INS Vindhyagiri' on August 17 at the Garden Reach Shipyard (GRSE) on the banks of the Hooghly River in Kidderpore, Kolkata, West Bengal.
- Named after the mountain range in Karnataka, this advanced enemy country's stealthy INS Vindhyagiri is the sixth version of the "Project 17A" warships.

The Central Water Authority has launched a mobile app called FloodWatch.

• **FloodWatch**, a mobile app to get information on real-time flood forecast conditions across India, was launched on **August 17**, **2023**.

The app has been launched with the aim of disseminating information related to all flood situations and forecasts for almost seven days on a real-time basis. It is significant that this app was launched by Central Water Commission president Kushvinder in New Delhi.

A Memorandum of Understanding has been entered into to share the India Stake.

- India and the Organization of Trinidad and Tobago have signed a Mutual Development Agreement (MoU) in August 2023 on sharing the India Stake.
- It is a collection of digital public goods, open APIs, and this MoU aims to facilitate identity, payment services and data at scale.

AICTE President has launched the Margdarshan Scheme 2023-24.

- Margdarshan Scheme 2023-24, a visionary initiative of All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) was successfully launched by AICTE President Prof. T. G. Seetharam on 16th August.
- The AICTE Chairman mentioned that this
 initiative has been launched with the aim of
 raising the standard of technical education
 across the country by providing dedicated
 guidance and its consistent efforts.

An MoU has been entered into between the Government of Rajasthan and NLC for supply of 300 MW of solar power.

- Central state-owned NLC India has on August 18 announced a joint venture agreement with the Rajasthan government's Urja Vikas Nigam (RUVNL) to supply nearly 300 MW of solar power under the CPSU scheme.
- NLC said that the agreement has been entered into with the primary objective of providing solar power for the next 25 years in the capital





of the state, Jaipur. It is noteworthy that this is the first time that NLCIL has expanded this capacity outside Tamil Nadu and so far it has included a 1.40 GW capacity in the southern state.

International news

Anwaar-ul-Haq Kakar has been appointed as the Care-Taker Prime Minister of Pakistan.

- The President of Pakistan Dr. Arif Alvi has approved the decision to appoint Balochistan Awami League Party (BAP) Senator Anwaarul-Haq Kakar as the Care-Taker Prime Minister of Pakistan in August 2023.
- The agreement was made after a consensus was reached between the **opposition** and **Prime**Minister Shehbaz Sharif during the talks held in the country's capital, Islamabad, on August 12, 2023. It is notable that he has previously served as the "Government Spokesman" of Balochistan from 2015 to 2017.

Anita Shah has been sworn in as Nepal's Union Affairs Minister.

- In a Cabinet reshuffle of Nepal, Nepal Prime Minister Pushpa Kamal Dahal has appointed Anita Devi Shah as the Union Minister of Public Administration and Federation to replace Aman Lal on 13 August 2023.
- With this, he has reshuffled the cabinet for the
 11th time. It is also significant that Dahal has already reshuffled the cabinet 10 times within 8 months of coming to power and with this appointment he has formed the 11th cabinet.

The UAE Modern Pentathlon Federation and Dubai Police have entered into a Memorandum of Understanding to enhance the country's sports cooperation.

 Dubai Police has signed a memorandum of understanding with the UAE State Modern Pentathlon Federation in August 2023 for

- cooperation and development in five disciplines: athletics, steeplechase, ab fencing, laser pistol shooting, 200m swimming and running.
- The MoU is aimed at establishing joint working groups for effective implementation of defined key objectives in the field of sports and efficient achievement of its shared goals.

An agreement has been signed to start the first direct flights between Israel and Vietnam.

- The two countries signed a memorandum of understanding on August 16 in Hanoi,
 Vietnam, to plan to launch the first direct flight between Israel and Vietnam.
- The partition agreement was signed in the presence of Israel's Economy Minister Nir Barkat and Vietnam's Chief Representative Nguyen Hong Dien. According to this, commercial flights between Vietnam's Hanoi and Israel's Tel Aviv will be started from October.
- It is also notable that "A Free Trade Agreement" was signed between the two countries last July.

The UAE and Ethiopia have entered into various development MoUs to boost the economies of both countries.

- The President of the United Arab Emirates, Sheikh Mohammed bin Zayed, and the Prime Minister of the Democratic Republic of Ethiopia, Abiy Ahmed, on August 18 signed various memorandums of understanding for the development of several institutions between the two countries.
- It is significant that these MoUs have been entered into with the aim of promoting economic development and cooperation between the two countries and **fostering corporate** partnerships.





The official website for the International Conference on Fishing Communities around the World 2023 has been launched.

- The International Conference on Fishing Communities Around the World 2023 (ICFC 2023) is scheduled to be held from September 19 to September 21 at the massive Busan Port International Exhibition and Convention Center (BPEX) in South Korea.
- The Maidan is planned to bring together union representatives of fishing communities from around the world and from different countries to address challenges, issues, transboundary fisheries disputes and develop cooperative solutions.

State news

"Trichy" has been selected as the best Municipal Corporation of Tamil Nadu.

- The Tamil Nadu Government has mentioned in a recent announcement that the Trichy Corporation has been selected as the Best Performing Corporation in Tamil Nadu for the year 2023. The award for this is going to be presented to the Mayor of Trichy on behalf of the Hon'ble Chief Minister.
- These awards are presented by Hon'ble Chief
 Minister of Tamil Nadu every year on
 Independence Day to the best performing
 Municipalities, Boroughs and Corporations
 in the state.

A project to build the country's largest new IT hub in Lucknow.

- The August 2023 announcement mentioned that preparatory work for setting up a new and country's largest IT center in Lucknow, the capital of the state of Uttar Pradesh, has been initiated by the Chief Minister.
- It has been announced that the State Rajkiya Nirman Nigam(UPRNN) has already drawn up a blueprint for setting up an IT Technology

Park and Center on nearly 40 acres and an International Incubation Facility on 6.9 acres in Amausi and Nadarganj Industrial Areas on Kanpur Road in the main city and work is underway.

The Union Minister has launched schemes to improve coastal defense in Gujarat.

- Union Home Minister Amit Shah has launched various development projects in August 2023 aimed at improving border and coastal security and building and upgrading its infrastructural facilities.
- In this, the new type of brigadier warships needed by the Navy and the installation of unmanned aerial vehicles for patrolling along the borders are seen as important.

An awareness and cleanliness drive has been organized in Ladakh.

- In the Union Territory of Ladakh, the State Department of Tourism, Rural Development and Panchayat Raj Department (RD&PRD), Roots Ladakh Organization and the State Wildlife Department have launched an initiative for an "Awareness and Cleanliness Movement" under the campaign "Meri Maati Mera Desh".
- The initiative was launched with the aim of creating awareness about the importance of forests, wildlife and environment and promoting tourism in the state and also about the serious issue of human-wildlife conflict.

CRPF 166 Battalion is planning to launch a colorful vehicle tiranga rally.

 In the Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir, CRPF 166 Battalion Force organized a vigil called Colorful Vehicle Tiranga on August 14, 2023 at Banihal Circle in Ramban District.





 JKP, CRPF, RPF, GRPF, PRI organization and army personnel and members and many local residents participated in this tiranga rally with the aim of making the people of the region celebrate their independence day well.

The intellectual giant National Media Conference 2023 has been held in New Delhi.

- The esteemed Rashtriya Navratna Awards 2023 and National Media Conference, a prestigious event on behalf of electronic and print media associations, was held at Vigyan Bhavan, New Delhi on 14th August 2023.
- From every corner of India, the best individuals and best organizations in the nominations for these prestigious awards will be honored with the prestigious Rashtriya Navratna Awards 2023.

Youth 20 Summit to be held in Varanasi.

- The Ministry of Sports and Youth Affairs has planned to host the "Youth 20" summit for 2023 on August 17 in Varanasi, Uttar Pradesh.
- The summit is likely to be held from August 17 to August 20. This conference aims to discuss these themes on the future of work, 21st century skills, climate change and disaster risk reduction, peace building and reconciliation: building an era without war and Industry 4.0, innovation as key goals for development.

The women's fare-free bus travel scheme is called 'Vidiyal Payanam'.

- In August 2023, Tamil Nadu Chief Minister M
 K Stalin announced that the free bus travel scheme for women in Tamil Nadu will now be called the "Vidiyal Payanam Scheme".
- On the occasion of Independence Day (August 15), the Chief Minister hoisted the national flag at the Chennai Chief Secretariat and then announced that various programs for women are

working well in Tamil Nadu and the free bus travel program for women will be called "Vidiyal Payanam Scheme" in the future.

Mobile app and emergency helpline launched for medical aid fund.

- Maharashtra Chief Minister Eknath Shinde on August 15 launched an emergency helpline and mobile app for the Chief Minister's Medical Assistance Fund.
- It is also significant that the book 'Rokhthok' based on the philosophy of Balasaheb Thackeray and the fifth edition of the medical aid manual was released on this occasion. He said that more than 12 thousand 500 patients have benefited from this financial assistance of the Chief Minister in the last one year, which is seen as important.

G20 Digital Economy Ministers and Digital Economy Working Group Summit held in Bengaluru.

- The G20 Digital Economy Ministers and Digital Economy Working Group Summit kicked off on August 16 in Bengaluru, Karnataka.
- The conference was inaugurated by Alkesh Kumar Sharma, Secretary, Ministry of Information Technology and Electronics. This conference is scheduled to be held from August 16 to August 19. The conference will be held under the theme of "Digital Economic Progress".

Wipro launches its new Center of Excellence for Innovative AI at IIT-Delhi

- Largest IT services provider Wipro has announced on August 16 that it will set up a center of excellence for its innovative AI technology to develop the system at the Yardi School of Artificial Intelligence (ScAI) on the IIT Delhi campus.
- The center, part of the institute's partnership with the university, is designed with the aim of





"Fostering talent, supporting fundamental and applied research and expanding the state of the art in the field and creating a special recognition for research and development," the institute said.

India's first unmanned aerial vehicle test facility to be set up in Tamil Nadu

- India's First Public Test Center for Unmanned Aerial Systems (Drone) under the Defense Test Infrastructure Scheme (DTIS) will be set up in Tamil Nadu by the Tamil Nadu Industrial Development Corporation (TIDCO) in its August announcement.
- The center is said to help make Tamil Nadu a
 preferred location for aerospace and defense
 companies to set up their Indian operations. It
 is reported that the center will be set up on an
 area of nearly 2.3 acres at SIPCOT Industrial
 Park in Vallam Vadagal near Sriperumbudur,
 Tamil Nadu.

The campaign 'My Bengal, Drug Free Bengal' has been launched.

- President of India Draupadi Murmu launched the "My Bengal, Addiction Free Bengal" campaign under the program "Nasha Mukt Bharat Abhiyan" at the Raj Bhavan in Kolkata, West Bengal on 17th August.
- It is significant that **President Murmu** said in the event that any drug addiction is formed due to stress, family unrest and various problems and this initiative has been started with the aim of bringing the youth out of such addiction.

G20 Health Ministers Summit to be held in Gujarat

- Under India's G-20 leadership, the G20
 Health Ministers' Summit will begin on
 August 17 in Gandhinagar, Gujarat.
- On the first day of the conference, the G20
 Deputy Ministers' Conference is scheduled to

- be held followed by the **Health Ministers' Conference** on the second day.
- The conference aims to discuss the topics of antimicrobial resistance, prevention of health emergencies, preparedness and building a health infrastructure.

India's first state-of-the-art 3D post office launched in Karnataka

- Union Minister Ashwini Vaishnav on August 18 inaugurated India's first 3D-designed post office building in Karnataka's capital Bengaluru.
- It is notable that the construction of this new post office building has been completed with the help of Larsen & Toubro and technical guidance from IIT Madras. It's a 3D structure built on nearly 1,021 square feet in the city's Cambridge-layout.

The first Maritime States Development Organization conference is scheduled to begin.

- Union Minister of Ports and Shipping Shri Sarbananda Sonowal will preside over the 19th Conference of the country's "Maritime States Development Organization (MSDC)" on August 18 and August 19 at Kevadia, Gujarat.
- It is significant that this conference is being held with the aim of discussing important issues related to the **overall development** and **progress** of the river and maritime sector.

The G20 Trade and Investment Ministerial Conference is scheduled to be held in Jaipur.

• The G20 Trade and Investment Ministerial Conference under Indian leadership is scheduled to be held in **Jaipur**, Rajasthan on **August 24.** It is a **two-day conference** to be held on **24th and 25th August.**





It is notable that this conference is being held with the **theme of discussion** on implementation of trade action plans presented by the President of India and building consensus on various issues related to global trade and investment.

Project for implementation of Bhagwan Birsa Munda Road Development Project in Maharashtra State.

- Maharashtra State Cabinet on 18th August 2023 announced the implementation of Bhagwan Birsa Munda Road Development Scheme to improve road connectivity in tribal areas in 17 districts of the state.
- According to the state government, the scheme is designed to connect the remote rural and hill tribal areas of the state with major roads.

August 14 The appointment makes Chopra the first woman to head PFC, India's largest non-banking financial institution. The company said that through this appointment, he is expected to improve the company according to his regular activities.

Science and Technology

Aditya-L1, the first spacecraft to explore the Sun, is scheduled to launch next month.

- ISRO has mentioned in its latest announcement that it is planning to launch India's first space satellite to study the Sun "Aditya-L1" in September.
- Developed at Bengaluru's UR Rao Satellite Technology Centre, the satellite is planned to launch from ISRO's premier Sriharikota launch pad. The spacecraft will be placed in a halo orbit around the "Lagrange point - L1" of the Sun-Earth system, nearly 1.5 million kilometers from Earth, with the aim of surveying the entire Sun.

Economic news

SBI plans to open nearly 300 branches across India in the current financial year.

- In its latest August 2023 notification, **State Bank of India** has approved the initiative to open more than **300 new branches across India** in the current financial year (2023-24).
- It is significant that SBI currently has around 22 thousand 405 branches across India and 235 overseas branches and offices. With this initiative, it is reported that there is a great opportunity to become the most branched buyer in India.

RBI has launched a Portal called "Udgam".

- The Reserve Bank of India has launched a centralized website on August 17, 2023 to facilitate the search for unclaimed deposits across all banks in India.
- Customers of any bank can register on the Udgam(Unentitled Deposit Information Gateway) platform using their mobile number and this portal is designed to facilitate access to the funds, the RBI said.

Sports news

Jannik Sinner has won his first Canadian Open title.

- Italian Jannik Sinner won his "first Masters 1000 title" at the Canada Open on August 13, defeating Australian Alex de Minaur 6-4 6-1.
- He is making his third Masters 1000 finals appearance after runner-up efforts at the 2021 and 2023 Miami Open, a hard-fought victory.





India's Mohit won the world title in men's under-20 61 kg wrestling category.

- Mohit Kumar of India has won the August 2023 World Championship in Men's Under-20 61kg Wrestling held in Amman, Jordan.
- In the final held on 16th August, Mohit won the title by defeating **Eldar Akhmadudinov of Russia** 9-8. With this, he became the **fourth Indian wrestler to win this title.**

Indian archers have won bronze medals in the 2023 World Cup.

- Indian recurve archers won two bronze medals in the men's and women's team events of the 2023 World Cup Phase 4 held on August 17.
- In this match, the Indian men's recurve team of Atanu Das, Dhiraj Bommadevara and Tushar Shelke defeated Spain's Andres Temino, Pablo Acha and Yun Sanchez by 6-2 (54-56, 57-55, 56-54, 57-55) points to retained the bronze medal.

Priya Malik has won gold at the U20 World Wrestling Championships for 2023.

- Indian athlete Priya Malik won the gold medal at the 2023 U20 World Wrestling Championship in Jordan in August 2023.
- With this win, she became the second Indian woman to win the U20 World Championship title. It is notable that before this last year Antim Panghal became India's first woman to win the junior world title in wrestling.

Indian air pistol team has won bronze in the world championship series.

- The Indian men's team of Sarabjot Singh, Shiva Narwal and Arjun Singh Cheema won bronze in the 10m air pistol event at the 2023 ISSF World Championships on August 17.
- With a total **score of 1,734**, they retained the medal, nine points behind **silver medalists**

Germany. It is also significant that the Chinese team has won the gold medal in this series.

India mixed air pistol team has won gold at the 2023 ISSF World Championships.

- Team India defeated Turkey to win gold in the 10m air pistol mixed event at the 2023 ISSF World Championships in Baku, Azerbaijan on August 18.
- It is notable that the Indian pair of shooters
 Shiva Narwal and Isha Singh defeated the
 Turkish team by 16-10 to win the medal. India
 is second in the ranking list while China's
 team is at the top with five gold and other
 medals.

Rana Pratap has won gold in the 2023 National Junior Aquatic Championship.

- Rana Pratap bagged Jharkhand's first individual gold medal at the 39th Sub Junior and 49th National Junior Aquatic Championships 2023 in Odisha's capital Bhubaneswar.
- It is also notable that he set a new national record of 2:21.88 minutes in the Division I Men's 200m category with sensational swimming skills.

Bindeshwar, founder of Sulabh International, passed away.

- Bindeshwar Pathak (age 80), social activist and founder of Sulabh International, passed away on August 15 at AIIMS in Delhi due to a heart attack.
- He founded Sulabh International, an international social service organization in 1970.
 He also carried out his major advocacy campaigns widely against "Manual Scavenging". It is notable that he was awarded the prestigious "Padma Bhushan" in 1991.





Eminent scientist and former DRDO chief Dr V.S. Arunachalam passed away.

- Eminent scientist and former DRDO-Chairman
 Dr VS Arunachalam passed away at the age of
 87 on August 16 due to old age in the US state
 of California.
- India's Prime Minister Modi condoled that Arunachalam's knowledge, interest in research and his contribution to strengthening India's defense capabilities were immense and his passing away left a great void in the scientific community and its strategic world.
- He also served as Scientific Advisor to the Union Defense Minister and was awarded the Padma Bhushan in 1985 and the Padma Vibhushan in 1990.

Important day

Pakistan Independence Day 2023

- Pakistan Independence Day is celebrated every year on August 14 to commemorate the day Pakistan gained independence and was declared a sovereign republic following the end of British rule in August 1947.
- It is significant that the All India Muslim League movement was conducted under the leadership of Muhammad Ali Jinnah and Pakistan was liberated.

Indian Independence Day

- 15th August is seen as the first day that the Indian country, which has been stuck under British rule for almost 300 years, will breathe the air of freedom.
- The day is celebrated to commemorate the day that started its journey of independence and became a democratic, republican and sovereign country and to honor the various sacrifices made to achieve this day.

Indonesian independence day 2023

• The fourth most populous country in the world and caught on the brink of Japanese and

- Dutch domination and occupation, **Indonesia** declared its independence on **August 17**, **1945**.
- It is an island nation with more than 17,000 islands. It is a country in Oceania, Southeast Asia between the Pacific and Indian oceans.

- This day was established by the United Nations in 2009. Also this day aims to honor the humanitarian aid workers (Social Workers) around the world. "It takes a village" is the theme for this year.

- World Photography Day is observed on 19th
 August every year to encourage people around
 the world to share their sense of the world
 through the lens and to honor and appreciate the
 impact of photography on society.
- "LANDSCAPES" is the theme for this year. The day also aims to commemorate the announcement of the daguerreotype process to the public on **August 19**, **1839** by the French Institute of Sciences.





World Mosquito Day 2023

- August 20 is observed every year as "World Mosquito Day" to commemorate British physician Sir Ronald Ross's discovery in 1897 that "Female mosquitoes transmit malaria to humans".
- There is no theme for this year. It is observed on this day for the purpose of creating awareness among the people of the world about the ways to protect ourselves from these diseases that can cause serious danger like malaria.

Akshay Urja Diwas 2023

- Akshay Urja Day is observed on 20th August every year with an aim to create awareness about the developments of renewable energy in India and confirm its major development projects among the general public.
- The day has been observed by the Ministry of New and Renewable Energy since 2004 and it is significant that the day commemorates the birthday of former Prime Minister of India, Rajiv Gandhi.
